### Local Railroad Seminar Held

During the weekend of August 12th through the 14th, railroad buffs, from across the Twin Tiers and beyond, attended the 'B&S, The Addison Connection' Seminar held within our community. The event was hosted by the Middletown Historical Society of Steuben County.

The B&S (Buffalo & Susquehanna) was a rail road that was in existence from the mid 1800's to the early 1900's in our area. The line ran from Buffalo south to the Pennsylvania line at Genessee then deep into the central part of the state. It also ran east and west through the northern tier and over the hill from Elkland to Addison where it met with the Erie Rail Road.

Friday's event featured a walk on the right of way at several spots from Addison to the PA line led by Chris Bigham. Saturday and Sunday's Seminars were held at the Addison High School Auditorium.

More than a dozen speakers covered, with ample visual material, all aspects of the development of the B&S. Included were the depots, the tanneries and Addison's Mosaic Glass factory that the B&S serviced. Several speakers spoke of the various commodities including leather, agricultural products, coal, lumber, glass, passengers, etc. that were the mainstays of the railroads shipping. Anecdotes related to its history were enjoyed by all.

As the attendees learned, the right of way was used by several railroads during its lifetime. The seminar closed with a pictorial essay of the last run of the 'WAG' (Wellsville, Addison & Galeton Rail Road), the last railway to use the right of way. A sad ending to a great part of our local history.

A delicious banquet, catered by Fran's Landing, was held for the participants at the Addison Legion Post 730 on Saturday evening where, once again, there was considerable discussion and viewing of visual material relative to the topic of the weekend.

All participants left the seminar with a better understanding of the railroad history of our community. The Middletown Historical Society of Steuben County would like to thank all of those that contributed to a very successful and enlightening weekend.

The Addison Farmers' Market is off to a good start. It's in the Main Street parking lot by the 5 corners, Saturdays from 8 to 2. I did a bit of comparison shopping this week. The average zucchini at Wegman's costs \$1.50. Zucchini at the farmers market last week was fifty cents each.

I'd like to remind your readers that every Saturday morning Grange members are getting up early to set up a pop-up shelter for everyone's use. It is big enough for 2 or 3 vendors to share.


So far, I have been the only one using it. Anyone who has produce or crafts to market can come share the shelter. If they only have a few things or don't have time to sit there all morning, I'll be glad to sell for them. There is no charge to set up at our farmers' market. It's free. Grangers are also working on the Community Garden. In a previous article, I told you we are there Mondays and Fridays 6:30-8:30PM. This week we will not be there Friday. We will be there Thursday instead. There are lots of cherry tomatoes. They are free for everybody. A note on cherry tomatoes. If they are harvested every day or two, they will keep putting out flowers and developing fruit right up until frost. In other words, the more you pick the more you will have.

It would be a great help if you would come harvest a pint or so on days we are not there. But if you have difficulty with harvesting, come while we are there and we will pick them for you. If you have questions, call me at 607-794-2822.

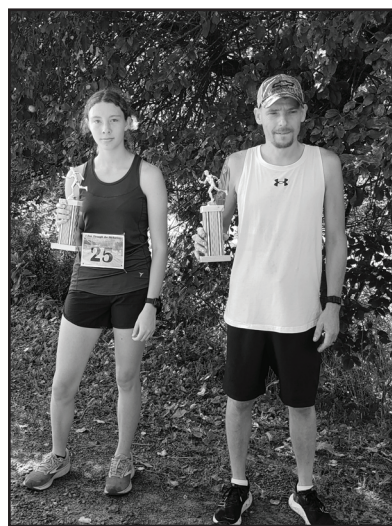
