Also not included were the Celia File Collection, Parks Collection, and Warner Collection, for which items the documentation is as yet incomplete.

USING THE INDEX

The index is in two parts. The first part, on white paper, is in order of item number ("negative number"). The second part, on buff paper, is a subject index. The white index shows all cross-references assigned to each item. By referring back to the white index, the user will often be able to ascertain quickly whether a photograph is likely to be useful or not.

The main entry occupies all columns across the page. Cross-references occupy only the first and second column.

When the collection contains more than one accessioned copy of a view produced from a single negative, both copies are shown, but only one negative number is used. If a single photograph was used in a variety of ways, for postcards, for instance, and in published sources, only one number is assigned as only one original negative is the origin of all copies.

Every effort has been made to validate the identification of each item. For instance, items are used as costume reference material only if the precise year the photograph was taken is known. Educated guesses are clearly defined by square brackets. In the date column, unverified years are followed by one of three codes: 1900a = after 1900; 1900b = before 1900; and 1900c = circa 1900. The letters were placed after the dates to aid machine retrieval.
