"This is by far my best year and there was a lot more kids," said AJ Hotaling.



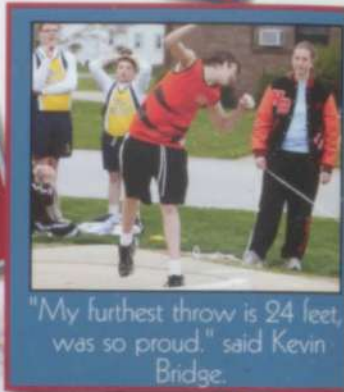
Kylie Hizer said, "I enjoy throwing shot, I have so many good memories in track."

Zach McCoy said, "The last day of shot-put I did so great, that was defiantly my best memory."

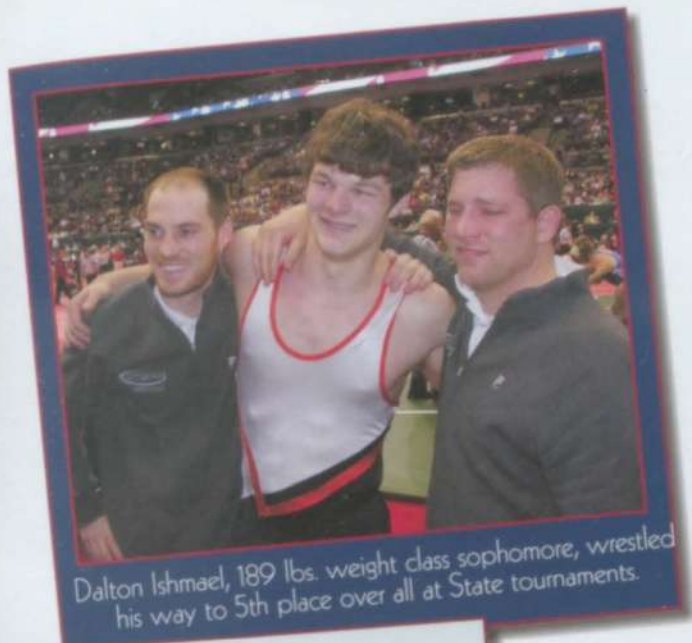

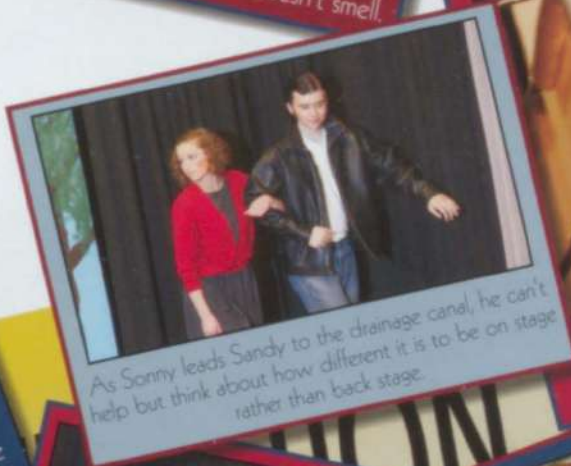

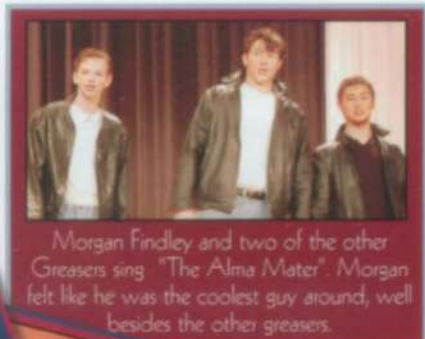

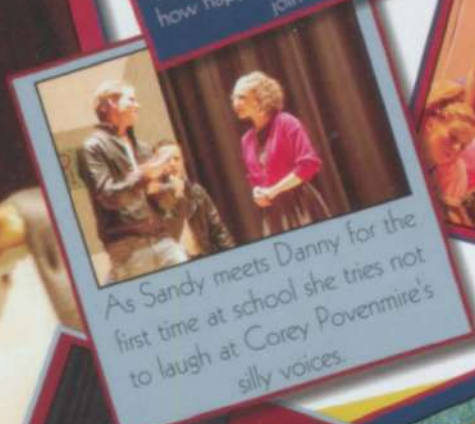

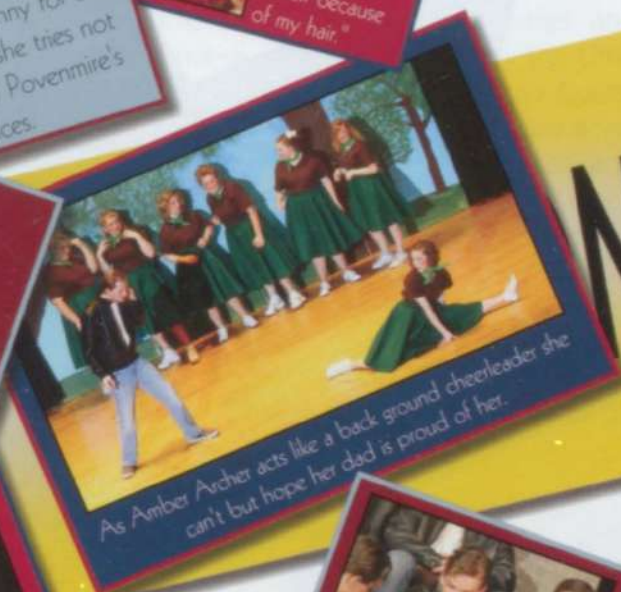

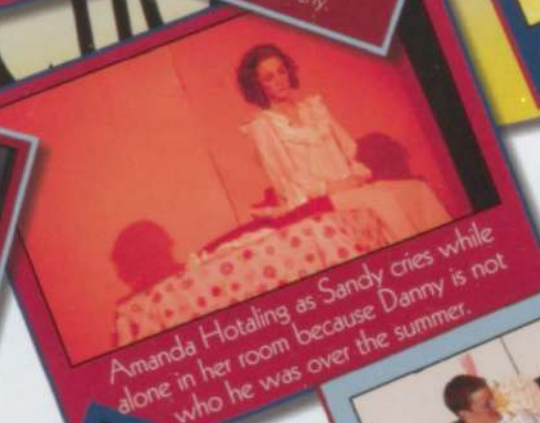

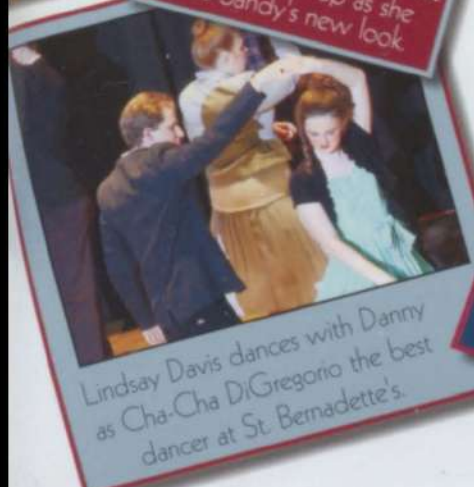

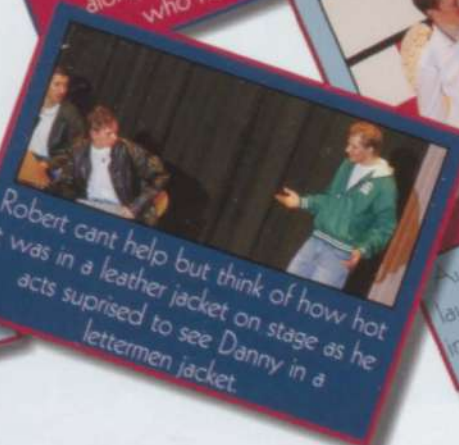

A NIGHT IN THE STARS

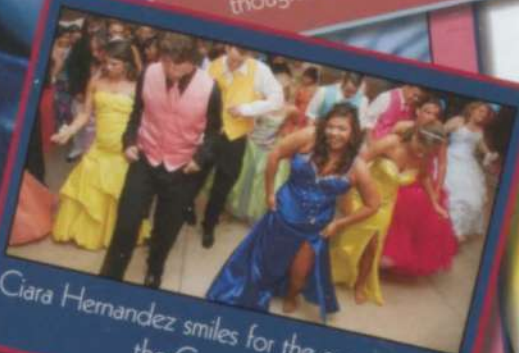

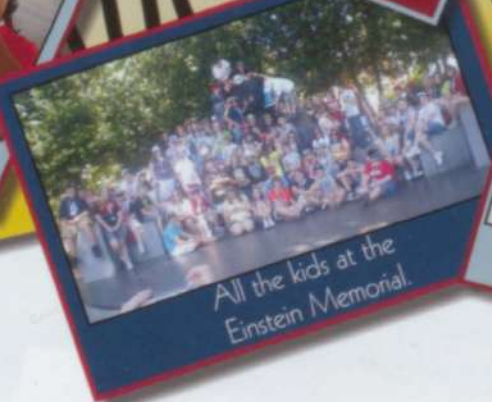
