

- 1. Easy Feet Bracket with pre-applied butyl mastic (1)
- 2. 5/16" x 3/4" stainless steel Turn Bolt (1)
- 3. 5/16" stainless steel Flange Nut (1)
- 4. 1/4" Deck Screws (4)
- 5. 1/4" Neoprene bonded stainless steel washers (4)

Tools Required:

- 1/2" Socket Wrench for 5/16" Turn Bolt
- 3/8" Socket Drill Attachment for Deck Screws
- Torque Wrench



INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

Installing Easy Feet[™] Bracket on a Composition Shingle or Metal Roof

Easy Feet Bracket can be attached to the roof using "Decking Attached" Fasteners" and without locating any rafters; however, the decking beneath the substrate must be of adequate thickness for a given type of material. Please consult a local engineer or fastener manufacturer for additional guidance if needed.

These guidelines begin after the mounting locations have been marked for each of the Easy Feet Bracket to be installed. For questions about the product, contact the Solar Technical Support Team at +1 800 260 3792.

Periodic Inspection


Periodic re-inspection is a recommended system maintenance procedure to check for any loose components and any corrosion. If any loose components or any corrosion is found, the affected components are required to be replaced immediately, with the original mounting system manufacturer's component parts.

INSTALLATION



From the bottom of Easy Feet Bracket, peel off the protective paper backing from the butyl mastic.

Align the Easy Feet Bracket to the substrate and press firmly, sticking it to the substrate. Install the neoprene bonded washers onto the screws with the rubber side down. Drive the screws into the substrate until the neoprene rubber protrudes from the washer edges. Attach the appropriate POWER RAILTM to the Easy Feet Bracket using the provided 5/16" x 3/4" Turn Bolt and Flange Nut. Torque to 14-16 ft-lb.





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
