7. Report Summary:

This is an (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) investigation.

This office received a Request For Investigation from Headquarters, USFOR-A, Kabul, AF, where it was reported an unarmed combatant was killed while in custody.

(b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) reported that following a "Green on Blue" incident, the combatant was taken into custody and transported to Camp Conde, AF, where he was interrogated by U.S. and Coalition Forces. Witnesses reported the combatant was later released to 4th Special Operation Kandak (SOK) Soldiers and taken off-camp. 4th SOK later contacted the Forward Surgical Team (FST), Camp Conde, AF, and reported the combatant was in bad condition and in need of medical attention. 4th SOK Soldiers subsequently transported the combatant to the FST where he was treated for what appeared to be critical blunt force injuries which were sustained by unknown means and by unknown persons. The combatant later died as a result of his injuries and pronounced by the FST at 0001, 23 Oct 18.

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CID conducted a crime scene examination of the room, where Mr. Wahedullah was assaulted. The room appeared to have been cleaned; however, blood spatter was identified on the walls and ceiling. A laboratory analysis of the blood spatter revealed the blood matched the DNA profile of Mr. Wahedullah.

(b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3)
(b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) were interviewed and denied they assaulted Mr. Wahedullah or were aware of the assault.

Interviews revealed Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) Mission Essential, Camp Conde, Afghanistan, acted (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) during the tactical questioning of Mr. Wahedullah by U.S. Soldiers.

Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) entered the room, where Mr. Wahedullah was being detained, and conducted biometric processing of Mr. Wahedullah. Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated after processing (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) repeatedly assaulted Mr. Wahedullah. He stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left the room; and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) entered the room. Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated as (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) questioned Mr. Wahedullah, (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left the room, and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) assaulted Mr. Wahedullah. Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) repeatedly assaulted Mr. Wahedullah, brandished a knife and threatened him. Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) then assaulted Mr. Wahedullah and threatened him.

Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) later approached him, and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) related to him "this never happened." Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) approached him again, later during the night, and related to him "this never happened, you didn't see anything," and told him to say the only thing that happened was tactical questioning and collection of biometric information from Mr. Wahedullah. Mr. (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) stated (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) made him repeat the statement back to them multiple times in order to ensure he knew what to say in the event he was questioned.

to know that not all AFGHANS think that way. At that point two Czech soldiers came up to us. I also saw out of the corner of my eye the shooter standing on his own. 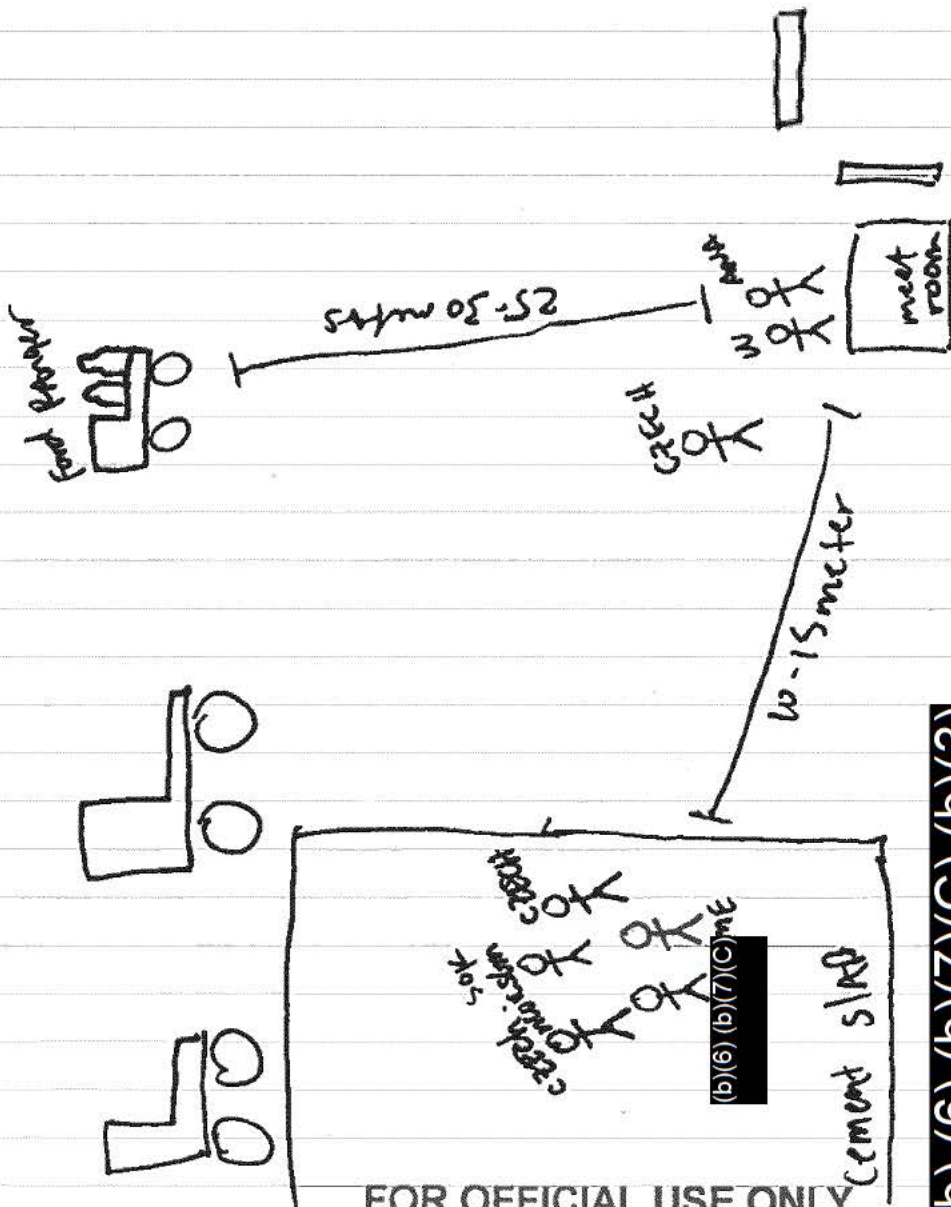

I then ran to the Czech OPCEN to get details from them. I saw the Czechs getting into full kit and getting their vehicles to provide what seemed to be QRF. They were only able to tell me the same thing the BDOC told me. I came back to the 7226 OPCEN when I was told by somebody that they Czech element in contact was back and they had three casualties in the FST. On my way to the FST I ran into (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) who told me there (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and they were attacked from the 4th SOK compound and they were working the 9 line MEDEVAC. This was probably around 1430. From that point on until around 1630 when the MEDEVAC helos showed up, I was constantly going back and forth from inside the FST, outside the building to those waiting for information, to the QRF on the road, and to the personnel at the gate coordinating. At some point shortly after 1430 I think, I was notified the 4th SOK Commandos had the shooter in their custody and was being questioned. I began to move between the FST and the South Gate where Czech Soldiers were and making coordinations for security. I informed the Czech QRF that the shooter had been captured by 4th SOK and the MEDEVAC was being called up. ODA 7226 were ready to escort casualties to the airfield but when we found out the UH-60s were on their way and would land at Camp Conde the vehicles were moved to security positions along the wall of the camp. I saw the 4th SOK SGM and an ANASF CPT talking (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) from the 4th SOK compound informed us the cell phone and everything the shooter had on him was secured for SSE and they would bring the shooter over for CF questioning when they were finished. While the helicopters were still there I was notified by JAG 50, JTAC for ODA 7222, a raven spotted an individual crawling towards the camp with a satchel. My guidance was to not shoot, let the situation develop, and if he picks up a weapon shoot. I then spent most of my time with (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) until the MEDEVAC helicopters took off at around 1700. I was then notified that the shooter had been brought to the maintenance and holding yard. I was surprised because I didn't see them come in or who brought the shooter in. When I walked over to the yard I saw the 18Fs from both SFODAs talking to the 4th SOK personnel, taking statements, and conducting SSE on the shooters belongings. I did not see the shooter as he was already in the building. I heard from one of the Czech SOF soldiers that they were told by their (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) at BAF that the shooter was to be transferred to BAF. Myself and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) came back to the OPCEN to conduct coordinations with our Company Commander (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) notified me that SOTF-A instructions were that the Czechs were not allowed to transfer the shooter to BAF themselves. (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) was also standing there at the tailgate. I saw the shooter laying there with a blanket on him and a neckbrace on and not moving. I asked (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) if he was alive and he said "I'm not sure if he made the trip". I helped carry the stretcher with (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and the medic (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) brought. We brought the stretcher into the FST where the FST team immediately went to work assessing him. While they were doing chest compressions (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) had a confused look on his face and asked "is he alive?". I told him it doesn't seem like it but the body was still warm so they are trying to do what they can. At some point the SGM from 4th SOK showed up in the room. I can't remember if it was (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) or the 4th SOK SGM that said they would be surprised if he lived after everyone at 4th SOK "had a go at him" (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) asked if everyone at 8th MSK had a go at him as well and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) smiled and nodded. I am not sure if he was agreeing or if he found it to be an amusing statement. Someone came in and notified (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and I that we got another phone call that required our attention. On our way out we heard the FST personnel declare the shooter was dead at around 0000 (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and I notified (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and the 4th SOK SGM said and that the shooter had expired.

At a time I can't remember that day when I was with (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) we walked into his office and shut the door with just the two of us in there. He was visibly upset and frustrated yet composed in everything he said. He had tears welling up as he told me "I want to kill him, that shooter needs to be dead, but I know I can't do that." It seemed he needed to vent in private where his guys couldn't see. According to what I saw of his body language and heard in his voice he truly understood the rules even if he was frustrated with it. I looked at him and I said "You're right you can't. Do your guys understand this as well?" He nodded yes but then walked into the next room over where his soldiers were and reminded them just to be sure.

My assessment of the Czech unit and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) after having worked closely with them for almost two months is that they take great pride in being one of the few countries allowed to go outside the wire and do not want to do anything to jeopardize that. They just want to go on missions with us and do their job like we do.

- A: I saw the shooter for the first time when he was brought on base for treatment at around 2345.

- A: Unknown if anyone took overall lead of TQ.
- Q: Do you have anything else to add to this statement?

At approximately 1430 on 22 OCT 2018, I was told by the BDOC that the Czechs had casualties after contact was taken on the 4th SOK Compound by the BDOC. I ran over to the FST, where the casualties had been taken to. (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) told me that SOTF needed to send a MEDEVAC helicopter for an urgent casualty. I moved back to the OPCEN to coordinate that MEDEVAC, and (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) After (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) moved back to the FST to get further updates on the situation and try to coordinate the MEDEVAC with them. I learned more about what happened with the shooting on the 4th SOK Compound. The Czechs were escorting a civilian truck onto Camp Conde, and had been engaged from within the 4th SOK Compound at the gate. 3 Czechs in the rear truck were the casualties, and after the attacker opened fire, the Czechs moved to the FST immediately (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) called 4th SOK to try to figure out more information about what happened. 4th SOK said that the attacker was in custody. There were a few Afghan personnel that were questioning him, and they were sending up a report on their end.

I got confirmation that MEDEVAC had been launched, and they were supposed to be on the ground at about 1615.

When the MEDEVAC arrived, the helicopters then departed Camp Conde at about 1710. The Afghans brought the attacker to the front gate in a truck about five minutes prior to the MEDEVAC leaving. I saw that the attacker was in the back of the truck. I led the truck on foot to the 18F's who began enrolling the attacker with all of the items that were found on the attacker. I did not really see the attacker as he was going to the building. The building was chosen by the ODA LVL IIIs on Camp Conde because it was far away from the MEDEVAC situation that was going on as well as away from the large numbers of individuals that were just standing around looking at everything that was going on (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) and I went back to the OPCEN to update AOB and SOTF on everything that was going on. At around 1745 I received information that the MEDEVAC was W/D at Herat for casualty transfer to an Arson Flight. At about 1930, I was told (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) that he had seen the shooter walk to the truck to be taken back to 4th SOK by 4th SOK CSM.

While I was writing reports and continuing to receive updates from SOTF and AOB, I received a call from (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) the SOTF S-3. This was sometime between 2000 and 2130. He said that there were reports that the shooter was about to die, and that (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) had called (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) and said that the Czechs had abused the shooter and were the cause of his condition. I found (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) and had him call the 4th SOK CDR (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) told me that (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) told him that he did not call (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) and tell him that the Czechs abused the shooter (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)(b)(3) told (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) that the 4th SOK had beaten the shooter after the shooter had returned from Camp Conde.

I had further phone calls and reports to send up to SOTF, as well as a conference call with (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3). Coordinations were then made with SOTF to have the shooter brought to the FST for evaluation and possible treatment. (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) called me and told me that the shooter was on the way and that he was expectant.

At about 2345 (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) brought the shooter to the FST. I was waiting at the FST with a camera to document the shooter's condition when he arrived. (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) was also there in the FST. The shooter was brought in on a litter with a neck brace on. The FST began attempting resuscitation on the shooter (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and I were in the FST with those two Afghan Leadership witnessing the treatment, as well as Ahmad. At approximately 0001 FST pronounced the shooter dead. They said that his body was still warm when he first arrived (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and the 4th SOK CSM were extremely calm throughout the entire treatment. (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) mentioned that he could not imagine how many guys had a go at him. I told him that it looked like basically all of 4th SOK and 8th MSK had taken out vengeance on him, and he shook his head and said yes. 4th SOK CSM did the same thing.

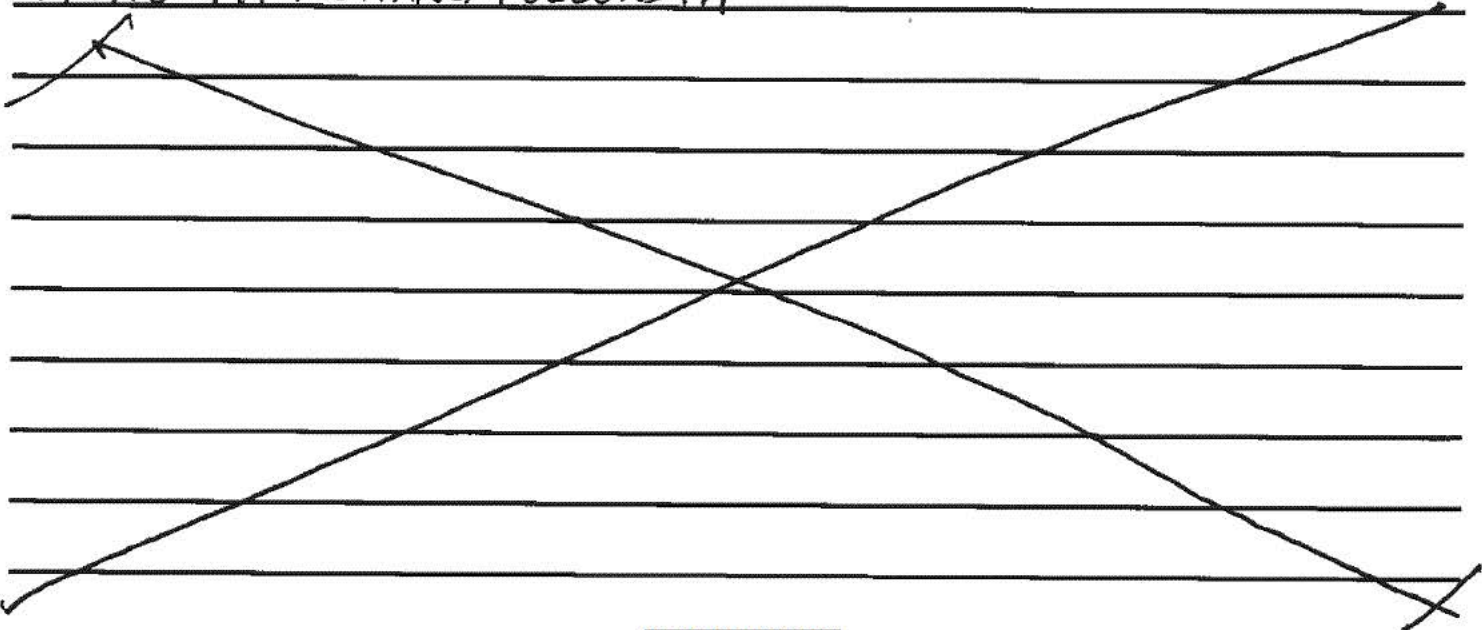

When (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and I entered the room at roughly 1720L, (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) were in the room (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) wiped down the suspects fingers and enrolled the suspect with the biosled. I stood in the left corner and observed. 5 minutes later (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left, and a couple minutes after that (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left - they were replaced by (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) led the tactical questioning, asking about his motive. The suspect opening admitted his guilt, citing that he lost his mind and made a mistake.

Second hand knowledge Apparently the Commandos who arrested the suspect said the suspect cited jihad in revenge for the American assassination (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3)

(b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) continued to ask questions, trying to catch the suspect in a lie. The suspect recalled Americans mortaring his village years ago and killed three women, whom he was unable to name. I asked a question about his small black phone number book, which the suspect referred it as a contingency should he lose his phone. After approximately 30 - 40 minutes of questioning (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) deduced we cannot get anymore information and decided to end the TQ. (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left the room, leaving the door open for approximately 4 Czechs to walk into the room. I waited in the room with the terp for approximately 15 seconds after (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) left to conduct hand-off with the Czechs. That was the last I saw the suspect.

Later in the night, I heard that the suspect was brought to the aid station on Camp Conde, where he later died. *Second hand knowledge* I was told during the team meeting, maybe the next day, maybe later in that day (I cannot remember) that (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) was standing next to an Afghan COL and another Afghan soldier, who openly stated everyone had a go beating him. When he returned, he was on a stretcher.

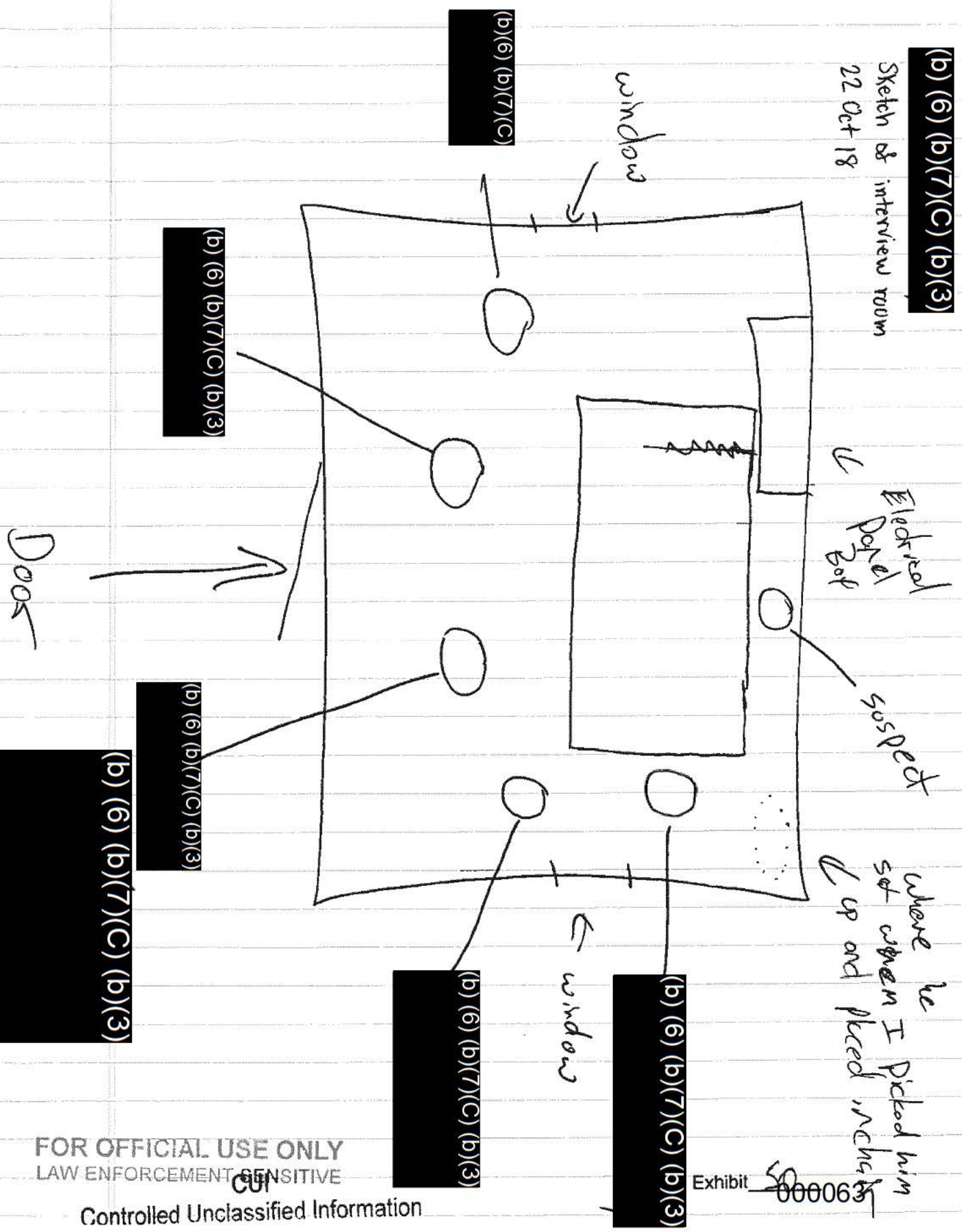

On 22OCT11 I woke up at approximately 0900 and ate breakfast at 0930. Between the hours of 1000 and 1200 ... and my self were continuing to prep demolition charges for our upcoming team photo later in the day. At approximately 1200 I went to lunch until approximately 1300 hours. After lunch I returned to my room and took a nap until approximately 1400 hours. ... and my self were supposed to leave for the range to set up the charges at 1500 hours. That was planned to give us approximately 2 hours to set up everything we needed to do the photo at 1700 hours. After I had gotten dressed and left my room at approximately 1415 to 1430 I had heard that the Czech SOF was in contact outside of Conde but no one had much information on it. Approximately 1440 Czech SOF had returned inside the perimeter of Conde with three casualties and they were transported to the FST. After hearing that news of the casualties ... and I agreed it would be best to cancel the team photo and push it to another day. There were more than enough medical personnel on the scene so I stayed away with the majority of the ODA and continued base defense posture. From 1440 to 1530 FST and medical personnel continued to treat the casualties. At approximately 1530-1600 hours Medevac finally pushed out from KAF. At approximately 1630 to 1645 Medevac helicopters arrived at Camp Conde. During that time members of 7222 stated that 4th SOK had the shooter in custody and was holding him for questioning. They had stated that they would bring him to Camp Conde for questioning after they were complete. At approximately 1710 4th SOK arrived with the suspected shooter in a Tan Ford Ranger with four or five 4th SOK commandos. The shooter was not in uniform at the time and in some kind of gray track suit with sandals. The suspected shooter entered the room with two or three members of the Czech SOF and an Afghan that I had never seen before where they began questioning for 10 to 20 minutes while the commandos remained outside. While the Czech SOF was questioning the shooter ... were searching through the personal belongings of the suspected shooter that was brought over in some dark colored cloth bag. At approximately 1720 to 1730 ... took custody of the suspected shooter and the Czech SOF and the other Afghan left the room while ... enrolled the suspected shooter into the biometric system that they have and it took approximately 5 to 10 minutes. Before ... and my self entered the room we agreed we would not speak to the suspected shooter or do anything for a full minute. ... was not briefed that we were going to do this and questioning started shortly after we entered the room. At approximately 1730 to 1740 ... and I entered the room. The shooter was on his knees facing the east wall with the table pushed all the way to the north side of the wall with a chair in the middle of the room ... assisted the suspected shooter to his feet and placed him in the chair while the table was moved to the center of the room. The shooter seemed to be nervous and was sweating heavily. I did not notice anything else on the suspected shooter other than he was hand cuffed with his hands to the side and did not want to make eye contact with anyone in the room. I was on the left side of the room next to the wall ... were in the middle of the room on the west side of the wall and ... was on the right side of the room on the Southern wall ... was already in the room on the left side next to my self. ... took lead on the questioning. The suspected shooter was asked why he had done what he had done and he jus...

(b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) explained that he went crazy. He kept repeating him self and told us that he let his commander know earlier in the day he wasn't feeling well and did not want to do his guard shift. His commander told him he had to do it any ways. When questioned who was supposed to replace him on guard or who he was supposed to replace he did not know any of the names of who was next or before him. He did not know the names of any of the soldiers he lived with, ate with, or prayed with because he was new to the unit and had only been there for five months. Again we asked him who hired him to do this or why he did it and he insisted he just lost his mind. We could not get him to explain if it was in retaliation or if he had ever been in contact with the Taliban beforehand. He stated he did not blame the US for General Rasiqs death and claimed he had just made a mistake. He claimed that Americans make mistakes all the time when they kill innocent civilians and it was the same as his mistake. When asked to further elaborate on that comment he just kept referring to that he went crazy. Questioning continued for approximately 45 minutes and we just kept going in circles with the same answers that he had given us previously. At that time we determined that we no longer wanted to question him and left the room where there was Czech SOF waiting to continue questioning him. At that time (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and my self with I believe (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) left the room giving custody to the Czech SOF. At that time I went to dinner chow. After dinner chow I went to shower and was notified I had to have my sworn statement done by 1900 hours. After typing my sworn statement I went to our nightly team close out meeting at 2000. In between 1900 hours and 2000 hours I remember hearing that the 4th SOK was given custody of the shooter and that he was walked back to their truck and left Camp Conde. After the team meeting I went to my room where I watched TV and talked to (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) on the phone. At approximately 2300-2400 hours I left my room to get something to eat before I went to bed. I walked towards our OPCEN and had heard that the shooter was just brought back onto Camp Conde and was in bad shape. I knew there was plenty of medical personnel on the camp and went to bed for the night at approximately 2400 to 0100 hours. The next morning of 23 OCT 18 I woke up at approximately 0900 and later in the morning had heard that the shooter had passed away the previous night.

He was sweating heavily.

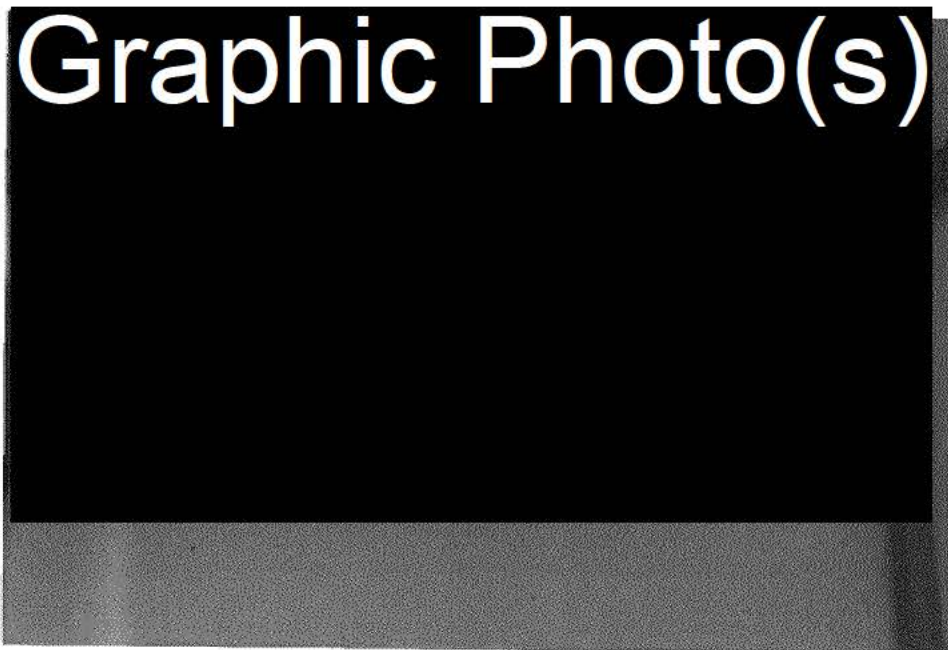

I was (I believe) in the FST (Forward Surgical Team facility) when a shot or shots were heard and very quickly after patients started to be carried in by members of the Czech SOF (Special Operations Forces) and I believe there were also American Soldiers/SF who assisted in moving the patients in. They were carried and not on litters. The most injured was put on the far trauma bed and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) and other FST team members immediately began working on him. Right following another Czech Soldier was placed on the 2nd trauma bed where myself and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) started to provide care. There were 1 or 2 other patients brought in or who walked in and they were getting treatment in the front section of the FST- they had minor injuries and I believe the Czech Medic and some others cared for those patients. I remember that the FST filled up very quickly with members of the SF Teams, the Czech SOF and uplift/Ops personnel. The critical patient did not survive his injuries. The others did and were MEDEVAC out. I remember the Czech team mates very emotional and I consoled/hugged several and gave condolences. We then began cleaning up the areas which probably took at least a couple hours. Several people helped us to reset to include (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3)

Czech team assisted and collected belongings for the patients. After this clean up we did a debrief in our FST with our personnel. I went on with my day- I was saddened by the loss (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) the Czech Soldier

I went to my room (in the FST building) at some point and went to bed.

Later in the night someone from the FST knocked on my door and said there was a patient coming from the Afghan SOF Camp across the road. I was inside of the treatment area when the patient arrived. I was recording in the patient chart and others performed interventions. I believe that the patient was brought over by Afghan Soldiers he was carried on a litter I seem to remember there would have been Americans there too because they should have been escorted from the gate by someone at the gate or from the Ops Cell. The Afghan SGM and (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) either came with them or shortly after. Also either prior to the patient arrival or shortly after there were some American Soldiers who came to assist- I believe (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) was there, (b) (6) (b)(7)(C) (b)(3) maybe one of the SF Team Sergeants? The patient had an IV in his arm, had a nasal airway in and I think he had a dressing on his head/face. The patient appeared unresponsive as he was brought in.
