### THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt wraps up a stretch of four road games in a five-game span Wednesday, Feb. 9 at Florida State. Tipoff is set for 9 p.m. with Mike Monaco and Malcolm Huckaby calling the game on the ACC Network.
- The Panthers have dropped 12 consecutive ACC road contests dating back to a 63-60 win at Syracuse Jan. 6, 2021. Pitt is 1-8 in road games this season with a non-conference win over St. John's at Madison Square Garden.
- Pitt leads the ACC and ranks 10th nationally in free throw attempts (511). The Panthers have shot more free throws than their opponent in 18 of 24 games played this season. Pitt also leads the ACC (20th NCAA) in made free throws (355).

- Pitt is averaging just 14.3 free throw attempts per game during its current four-game losing skid.
- **Femi Odukale** has scored 15 or more points in each of the past four games. He is averaging 20.0 points per game, while going 27-of-44 (.614) from the field, including 10-of-15 (.667) from three-point range.
- **Jamarius Burton** had a string of 16 consecutive double-figure scoring games snapped Monday. He has scored 10 or more points in 12 league games and is averaging a team-high 14.2 points per game in ACC play.
- **Mouhamadou Gueye** is 10-of-20 (.500) from three-point range, while averaging 12.3 points and 2.3 blocks per game over the past three games.

## BY THE NUMBERS

- **Jamarius Burton** leads the Panthers with 17 double-figure scoring games. He has topped the 20-point mark five times and scored 15 or more points eight times this season.
- **John Hugley** has scored in double figures 16 times, including a team-high six games with 20 or more points. He leads Pitt in scoring (14.2 ppg.), rebounds (8.1 rpg.), offensive rebounds (62), field goals (107), free throws made (122), free throw attempts (168) and double-doubles (7).
- **Mouhamadou Gueye** leads the Panthers in three-point field goals (32) and blocked shots (47). He is the only player in the ACC to lead his team in both categories and is attempting to become the first Pitt player to lead the team in both categories in a season.
- **John Hugley** ranks 14th in the NCAA in free throw rate (69.1 pct.) and is 20th in fouls drawn per 40 minutes (6.8).
- **John Hugley** (168) and **Femi Odukale** (130) have combined for 298 of the team's 511 free throw attempts (58.3 pct.). The tandem has combined to shoot 15 or more free throws in a game 10 times.
- **Mouhamadou Gueye** is averaging 10.7 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.4 blocks in 19 games when playing 25 minutes or more. He has scored in double figures 12 times and blocked two or more shots in 13 of those games.
- **Femi Odukale** is averaging 16.0 points per game when he makes at least one three-point field goal. He has scored in double figures in 13 of the 14 games this season when he has made a three.
- **John Hugley** leads the league in free throw attempts (7.0 ftag.) and free throws made (5.1 ftag.), while shooting 72.6 percent (122-of-168) from the charity stripe. He has been limited to just 11 free throw attempts in the past four games, including no attempts in Pitt's two games against Virginia Tech.

- **Femi Odukale** has recorded at least one assist in 30 consecutive games dating back to last season. He has recorded three or more assists in a game 18 times this season.
- **Mouhamadou Gueye** is averaging 2.87 blocks per game over the past seven contests. He has blocked two or more shots in nine of Pitt's 13 league games.
- **Jamarius Burton** is averaging 14.4 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game, while going 62-of-132 (.470) from the field, including 12-of-31 (.387) from three-point range over the past 12 contests.
- **Jamarius Burton** is averaging 23.0 points in the paint and 14.8 points from the foul line per game. Interior scoring and foul shots have accounted for 61.4 percent (911-of-1484) of the team's points. The Panthers have scored just 83 of their 193 points (43.0 percent) in the paint and from the free throw line over the past three games.
- The Panthers rank third in the NCAA in free throw rate (42.4 percent) and fourth in points distribution from the foul line (23.9 percent). Pitt is tied for 23rd the NCAA in free throw attempts per game (21.3 ftag.) and have outscored the opposition by 85 points from the free throw line.
- Pitt has held the opposition to 28.6 percent (55-of-192) shooting from three-point range in its eight wins. By contrast, the opposition has shot 39.3 percent (151-of-384) from beyond the arc in wins over the Panthers.
- Pitt is averaging 43.4 points per game, while shooting 62.7 percent (47-of-75) from the field in the second half of the past three games. **Femi Odukale** is averaging 16.0 points per game on 17-of-23 (.739) shooting from the field in that span.
- The Panthers past three opponents have shot 55.0 percent (83-of-151) from the field, including 51.2 percent (42-of-82) from three-point range.

## PANTHER SPOTLIGHTS



- **Mouhamadou Gueye** is 23 blocked shots shy of 200 career blocks. He has blocked at least one shot in eight consecutive games and has 22 blocks (2.8 bpg.) in that span.



- **Femi Odukale** has led the Panthers in scoring in each of the past four games and is averaging 20.0 points per game on 27-of-44 (.614) shooting from the field.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Pitt fell to Virginia Tech for the second time in three days Monday at Cassell Coliseum in Blacksburg, Va. The Hokies used a 17-0 first half run to take control of the game en route to a 74-47 win.
- **Femi Odukale** scored a team-high 16 points to go along with four assists and two steals. He was 5-of-8 from the field, including 2-of-3 from three-point range, and 4-of-4 from the foul line.
- **Mouhamadou Gueye** made a career-high five three-point field goals to finish with 15 points. He added four blocks in the game for his eighth game this season with three or more blocks.
- **William Jeffress** came off the bench to knock down a pair of three-point field goals and finish with eight points.
- Pitt went 10-of-20 (.500) from three-point range, but were just 5-of-20 (.250) on its two-point attempts.
- The Panthers were outrebounded 36-19 in the contest, including a 10-1 margin in offensive rebounds. Pitt entered the game second in the ACC in rebound margin.
- Pitt shot 50 percent from the field in the second half of play, marking the third consecutive game the Panthers have shot 50 percent of better from the field after halftime.

## GETTING TO THE LINE

- Pitt has shot 20 or more free throws in a game 14 times and leads the ACC (T-24th in NCAA) with 21.3 free throw attempts per game.
- The Panthers also lead the ACC with 14.8 made free throws per game and have made 15 or more shots from the charity stripe 14 times.
- **John Hugley** and **Femi Odukale** both rank among the league leaders in free throws made and free throw attempts. The duo has combined for 10 or more made free throws in a game nine times.
- Hugley and Odukale rank first and third, respectively, in the ACC in free throw attempts per game. The tandem combines for 12.7 free throw attempts per contest.

## BIG LIFT INSIDE FROM BIG JOHN

- **John Hugley** ranks among the league leaders in scoring (17th - 14.2 ppg.), rebounds (5th - 8.1 rpg.), offensive rebounds (5th - 2.58 orgp.), defensive rebounds (8th - 5.54 drpg.) and double-double (3rd - 7).
- Hugley has scored in double figures nine times in league play and is averaging 13.8 points and 7.8 rebounds per game against ACC opponents.
- Hugley ranks second in the NCAA in free throw attempts (168) and fifth in made free throws (122). He has shot eight or more free throws in a game 12 times, including seven times in ACC play.
- Hugley scored in double figures in five consecutive games from Nov. 27 thru Dec. 12, averaging 18.8 points per game in that span. He also posted three of his team-leading four 20+ point games during this stretch.
- Hugley has grabbed three or more offensive rebounds in a game 11 times, including a season-high eight offensive boards in a home win over Syracuse.
- Hugley became the third Pitt player since the 1986-87 season to post 25 or more points and 10 or more rebounds in the season opener. He recorded his first career double-double with 27 points and 10 rebounds against The Citadel. Hugley set then career highs for points (27), rebounds (10), offensive rebounds (5), field goals (10), field goal attempts (20), free throws (7), free throw attempts (13) and minutes played (35) in the contest.
- Hugley posted 17 points, six rebounds and two assists at West Virginia. He was 7-of-10 from the field and scored all 17 points in the second half of play.
- Hugley posted his second career double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds in a win over UNC Wilmington. He was 5-of-5 from the foul line and added a career-best three assists against the Seahawks.
- Hugley went 8-of-10 from the field en route to a 21-point, seven-rebound effort versus UMBC.
- Hugley scored 25 points and added 14 rebounds (5 offensive boards) in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge against Minnesota. He scored 16 consecutive points for the Panthers over a 10-minute span and finished the game 9-of-16 from the field.
- Hugley went 7-of-8 from the foul line and finished with a team-high 12 points at Virginia.
- Hugley recorded his fourth 20+ point game in a win over Colgate. He finished with 22 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 from the foul line. Hugley also had career-bests in steals (2) and blocked shots (2).
- Hugley scored 14 points and grabbed 13 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season against Monmouth.
- Hugley posted 18 points, six rebounds, three assists and a career-high three steals against Notre Dame. He also made a career-best eight free throws, going 8-of-9 from the charity stripe.
- Hugley finished with 11 points and seven rebounds despite being limited to 19 minutes of play against Louisville.
- Hugley became the fourth player since the 2008-09 season to post a 30/10 game, finishing with 32 points and 13 rebounds in a home win over Boston College. He became the 14th Pitt player (29 times) to record a 30/10 game.

• Hugley's 32-point effort was one-point shy of the Pitt Petersen Events Center scoring record shared by Trey McGowens (2018-19) and Sam Young (2008-09).

• Hugley delivered 19 points, seven rebounds and two steals in a win over Louisville. He had 14 points and six rebounds in the second half of play as Pitt posted its largest win of the season.

• Hugley recorded his sixth 20+ point scoring game at home against Virginia. He finished with 23 points on 7-of-14 shooting from the field and 8-of-9 from the foul line.

• Hugley went 7-of-8 from the foul line and finished with 15 points and eight rebounds at Clemson.

• Hugley grabbed a career-best 18 rebounds, including eight offensive boards, and added 11 points for his sixth double-double in a win over Syracuse.

## BURTON ON A TEAR

• Senior guard **Jamarius Burton** has scored in double figures a team-high 17 times and is second on the team in scoring at 12.9 points per game.

• Burton has elevated his play in the ACC averaging 14.2 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, while shooting 45.8 percent (66-of-144) from the field, 39.4 percent (13-of-33) from three-point range and 86.6 percent (39-of-44) from the foul line.

• Burton scored 10 or more points in 16 consecutive games from Dec. 3 - Feb. 5 and averaged a team-high 15.2 points per game, while shooting 89.7 percent (52-of-58) from the foul line in that span.

• Burton made 31 consecutive free throws from Dec. 18 thru Jan. 19, tied for the fifth longest streak in program history. He ranks fourth in the ACC in free throw percentage (.870).

• Burton made his Pitt debut Nov. 16 against UNC Wilmington after missing the previous five weeks due to a knee injury. The Charlotte, N.C., native had a successful procedure on his left knee in early October. He scored seven points in 25 minutes against the Seahawks.

• Burton posted his first double-figure scoring game in a win over Towson. He finished with 11 points (all in the second half), four rebounds and four assists.

• Burton scored 11 points and added three rebounds and four assists in a career-high 39 minutes of action at Virginia.

• Burton scored 13 points and added five rebounds in a win over Colgate.

- Burton posted 15 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field against Monmouth.
- Burton scored 20 points, including the game-winning bucket with 0.4 seconds remaining, in a road win over St. John's. He scored eight of Pitt's final nine points of the game.

## ODUKALE ON POINT

- **Femi Odukale** is averaging to 12.7 points, 3.4 rebounds and 3.2 assists in 33.0 minutes per game this season. He has scored in double figures 16 times, including nine of the past 10 contests.

## GUEYE FILLING THE STAT SHEET

- **Mouhamadou Gueye** is averaging 9.1 points and 5.9 rebounds in 28.5 minutes per game. He leads the team in blocks (47) and three-point field goals (32).
- Gueye is the only player in the ACC to lead his team in blocks and three-point field goals. He is attempting to become the first Pitt player to lead the team in both categories.
- Gueye ranks fourth in the ACC in blocks per game (1.96 bpg.) and is attempting to become the first Panther since Steven Adams (2013-14) to average 2.0 blocks per game or better.
- Gueye has recorded two or more blocks in 49 of 78 career games. He posted a season-high five blocks in Pitt's outing at Clemson.
- Gueye has grabbed five or more rebounds in 58 of 78 career games. He is averaging 6.5 rebounds per game for his career.
- Gueye grew 10 inches over the course of his high school career and has grown an additional three inches in college to now stand at 6-10 with an 87 inch wing span.
- Gueye recorded his first double-figure scoring game as a Panther and the 19th of his career at West Virginia. He finished with 10 points, four rebounds, two assists, one steal and three blocks against the Mountaineers.
- Gueye made a career-best four three-point field goals and finished with 14 points to go along with six rebounds and a blocked shot against UMBC.
- Gueye grabbed 11 rebounds, including three offensive boards, versus Minnesota.
- Gueye finished with 10 points, six rebounds and two blocks in a win over Colgate. He converted a three-point play in the closing minute of play to tie the game.
- Gueye scored a season-high 15 points and added six rebounds and three blocks in a win at St. John's. He went 6-of-6 from the free throw line to extend his streak to 12 consecutive made free throws.
- Gueye recorded his first double-double as a Panther against Jacksonville. He finished the game with season highs in points (15), rebounds (12), assists (4) and blocks (4).

## HORTON RETURNS

- **Ithiel Horton**, one of the top returning three-point threats in the ACC, averaged 8.9 points and making 43 three-point field goals last season.
- Horton has scored 664 points (11.1 ppg.) and made 129 three-point field goals in 60 career games at the Division I level. He is shooting 39.4 percent (129-of-327) from beyond the arc in his career.
- Horton was suspended following an off campus incident Nov. 6. Due to the nature of the incident involving Horton, he was suspended automatically from practice and competition privileges until the legal process has been completed to the satisfaction of the University.
- Horton was reinstated to the team Dec. 30 and began practicing the following day.
- Horton scored 13 points and added four rebounds in his season debut at Louisville. He was 5-of-9 from the field, including 3-of-5 from three-point range.
- Horton missed six games from Jan. 8-25 after charges were refiled after his case was dismissed by a judge Dec. 30.
- Horton's case was resolved Jan. 26 and he was reinstated to the program immediately.
- Horton knocked down three three-point field goals and finished with 11 points, three rebounds and two steals at Boston College.

## EZ [EAKUDO] DOES IT

- Former walk-on guard **Onyebuchi Ezeakudo** has worked his way into the starting lineup and was placed on scholarship for the Panthers. He has started each of the past eight games and 11 games overall.
- Ezeakudo is averaging 2.6 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 21.4 minutes per game, while shooting a team-high 42.5 percent (17-of-40) from three-point range.
- Ezeakudo made his first start of the season at Virginia. He knocked down a pair of three-point field goals and finished with eight points and three rebounds.
- Ezeakudo scored a career-high 11 points in a home win over Syracuse. He went 4-of-6 from the field, including 3-of-4 from three-point range, and added three rebounds and three steals.
- Ezeakudo knocked down a pair of three-point field goals and finished with eight points, a career-high four assists and two steals at Wake Forest.
- Ezeakudo scored eight points and went 2-of-3 from three-point range at home against Virginia Tech.

## JEFFRESS ACTIVE ON THE BOARDS

- Sophomore **William Jeffress** has been active on the boards in 2021-22, collecting five or more rebounds in a game eight times. He has also grabbed at least two offensive rebounds six times.

- Jeffress recorded eight points and seven rebounds at West Virginia while also limiting Taz Sherman to just 6-of-20 shooting from the field.
- Jeffress posted a career-best nine rebounds to go along with seven points and three steals in a win over UNC Wilmington.
- Jeffress delivered seven points, six rebounds and a career-high four assists with no turnovers in a win over Towson.
- Jeffress made a career-high three three-point field goals and finished with nine points and eight rebounds against UMBC.
- Jeffress matched a career high with nine points to go along with three rebounds and two blocks in a win over Colgate.
- Jeffress grabbed six rebounds, including three offensive rebounds, at Clemson.
- Jeffress knocked down a pair of three-point field goals and finished with eight points at Virginia Tech.

## EFFICIENCY FROM OLADAPO

- **Dan Oladapo** is averaging 3.3 points per game, while going 20-of-25 (.800) from the field in 10.7 minutes per game.
- Oladapo went 4-of-4 from the field to finish with eight points at West Virginia. He grabbed three rebounds, including a pair of offensive boards in the contest.
- Oladapo had nine points against UNC Wilmington in his first start as a Panther. He added five rebounds, including four offensive boards, in the win.
- Oladapo scored 11 points and added four rebounds and two assists in a win over Towson. He went 4-of-4 from the field and 3-of-4 from the foul line against the Tigers.
- Oladapo missed Pitt's game at Louisville due to health and safety protocols.

## SANTOS MAKES EARLY START

- **Nate Santos** became the 22nd freshman in program history to start the season opener. The Panthers have started at least one freshman in the season opener in four straight seasons.
- Santos set season highs in points (14), rebounds (8), three-point field goals (4) and steals (2) in a win over Towson. His four three-point field goals against the Tigers is tied for the eighth most in a game by a Pitt freshman.
- Santos finished with 11 points and a team-high six rebounds against Vanderbilt.

## TRANSFER PORTAL ADDITIONS

- Pitt used the transfer portal to add three impact players who have produced at the Division I level. **Jamarius Burton** (Wichita State/Texas Tech), **Mouhamadou Gueye** (Stony Brook) and **Dan Oladapo** (Oakland) have now combined for 2,306 points, 1,354 rebounds and 518 assists over 269 career games.
- Burton averaged 7.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game over 90 career contests (56 starts) over three seasons at Wichita State and Texas Tech. As a sophomore, he averaged 10.3 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.4 assists, while shooting 38 percent from three-point range for the Shockers.
- Gueye averaged 9.7 points, 7.1 rebounds and 3.1 blocks per game and was named America East Defensive Player of the Year last season at Stony Brook. He set school records for blocks per game in a season and career blocks per game (2.38 bpg.).

• Oladapo posted 12.9 points, 8.8 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.1 steals per game, while shooting 56.9 percent from the field a year ago at Oakland. He finished the season ninth in the NCAA in offensive rebound (3.8 oppg.) and was a Second Team All-Horizon League selection.

• **Nike Sibande** will miss the 2021-22 season after suffering a torn ACL in the first half of Pitt's exhibition win over Gannon Nov. 1.

• Sibande will seek a medical redshirt to receive an additional season of eligibility. He underwent successful surgery his knee Nov. 19.

• Sibande has totaled 1,570 points, 532 rebounds, 155 assists and 96 steals in 111 career games (103) at Miami [Ohio] and Pitt. Last season, he averaged 6.9 points and 3.0 rebounds in 19.6 minutes per game after missing the first seven games of the season while waiting on NCAA eligibility ruling.

• Sibande closed the 2020-21 season on a high note averaging 15.0 points, 6.2 rebounds and 2.6 assists over the final five games of the season. He posted a season-best 24 points with five three-point field goals in the opening round of the ACC Tournament against Miami.

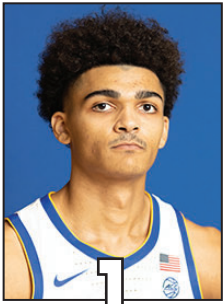

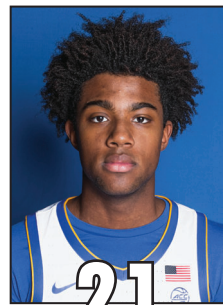
