The Iseli Company/Terryville used Solvent Recovery Service to recycle their used product of Tetrachloroethylene and purchased back the amounts reclaimed.

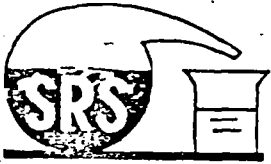
Under the assumption that we are to be paying for our portion of what may have been Landfilled, our liability in this case would presumably be reduced by approximately half.
