Dear Mr. Levine:

As you are aware, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has concluded that, prior to issuance of a Proposed Plan and Record of Decision for the groundwater at the Goldisc site, additional sampling will be required for the selected monitoring wells. As indicated in our April 10, 1997 letter to Mr. John Iannone of ERM, such a sampling should occur within three to four months after the soils and sediments excavation. This sampling event is important in order to determine the existing nickel concentrations in the groundwater and to address any positive effects the remediation may have had on the quality of the groundwater. Monitoring wells: MW- 7A, 7B, 7C, 8R, 9R, 10R, 11R, 12, 14, 16, 17s, 17i, and 17d should be sampled by November 14, 1997. Please provide us with a schedule for this event.

If you are unable to perform the sampling within this timeframe, EPA will perform the sampling. In order to enlist our staff enough time to prepare for this sampling activity, please provide us with a response to this letter by October 22, 1997.
