Credit cards in MCX

The Marine Corps Exchange here, at Camp H.M. Smith and at Marine Barracks Hawaii will accept Visa and Mastercard charge cards starting Jan. 11.

At Kaneohe Bay, credit cards can be used at the Self-Service, Customer Service, Military Clothing Sales Store and at the Main Exchange. They can also be used at the Golf Pro Shop and at the Service Station, but only for merchandise and service.

At Camp Smith and Marine Barracks, credit cards will be accepted at the Main Exchange Stores and at

the Service Stations, but they cannot be used for purchasing gasoline.

There is no minimum amount which can be charged, as it depends on the individual's credit limit. When requesting refunds for items purchased with credit cards, customers must show the receipt from the card.

Credit cards will not be accepted at food service activities, 7-Day Store, vending activities, Troop Stores or service facilities. If you have any doubts, ask the sales clerk if cards are accepted before making a purchase.

SNCO degree program

Eligibility requirements and academic disciplines available under the Staff Noncommissioned Officer Degree Completion Program for FY-86, are listed in ALMAR 287/85.

Applications will only be considered from individuals in balanced or over MOSs, primarily from staff sergeant and gunnery sergeant. Marines in the OccFld 34 can waive this requirement if

they are applying for either financial management or accounting degrees.

Applications will only be considered for financial management, criminal justice, psychology, safety, accounting, and education with concentration in guidance and counseling only.

CFC ends; tops goal of 2.5 mil

The 1985 Hawaii-Pacific Area Combined Federal Campaign ended with donations totaling \$2,588,678.43 attaining 101.11 percent of the goal at the end of the drive.

The final amount won't be known for several weeks when the last of the donations are received from deployed military units.

The Marines hit 114 percent; the Air Force achieved 105 percent; and the Army collected 101 percent. The Navy so far has attained 98 percent, but still has 3,000 sailors to hear from.

The annual charity drive among Hawaii's 90,000 military people and federal civilian employees is an effort involving some 4,400 campaign workers, all volunteers. Less than three percent of the funds collected go toward overhead.

Over 90 percent of the money collected in the local campaign has stayed in Hawaii. The remainder goes to a variety of national and international groups. In all, over 100 agencies benefit from the annual drive.

VA pension checks increase

Veterans, spouses and children residing in Hawaii, Guam and American Samoa will receive a 3.1 percent increase in veterans administration's pension checks for January, according to Sam A. Tiano, director of the Honolulu VA Regional Office.

The increase will also apply to parents of deceased veterans eligible for Dependency and Indemnity Compensation benefits. Adjustments are based on a

rise in the Consumer Price Index during 1985 payable beginning with January checks.

Veterans and survivors who have elected to receive "improved" VA pension benefits will get the raise, required by law, effective the same date as increases in Social Security benefits. These provisions apply to DIC recipients as well.

Under the "old" plan, pensions for veterans and

survivors remained fixed at rates effected in 1978. However, such rates are protected against termination that could result from cost-of-living index increases in Social Security income received by those still under the old plan.

Old plan recipients may request transfer to the "improved" plan at any time.

Nationally, more than 414,000 veterans, 247,000 spouses, 18,000 children and

41,000 parents will receive the increases. Unlike compensation paid to veterans disabled because of military service, pension paid to wartime veterans totally and permanently disabled from circumstances unrelated to their military service, and to needy survivors of wartime veterans, are affected by income from other sources.

F-4s first to land

Runway back in business

The roar of jet engines and the screech of tires touching down here on Friday marked the return of fixed-wing aircraft 10 months after the runways were closed for renovation.

"I feel more like an air station commander now," remarked Colonel Robert P. Rogers, as the runway became operational for the first time since he assumed command of the Air Station last June.

The first F-4 Phantom aircraft to land on the resurfaced runways snapped

a yellow ribbon with its arresting gear. It was piloted by Col. J.D. Howell Jr., commanding officer of MAG-24, and Radio Intercept Officer, LtCol. W.L. Nyland, commanding officer of VMFA-232.

A few minutes later, a Phantom from VMFA-235, piloted by the squadron's commanding officer, LtCol. P. Skeldon and Radio Intercept officer, LtCol. J.L. Witter, commanding officer of H&MS-24 landed and taxied next to the first aircraft.

The pilots were met by their

wives, as well as Col. Rogers and BGen. Richard A. Gustafson, deputy commanding general, FMFPac.

The rest of MAG-24's

Marines and aircraft returned from NAS Barbers Point, where they had been deployed during the renovation.

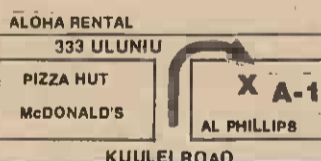

Following the marching infantry units, the regiment's equipment was paraded past the viewing stands as the FMFPac Band struck up a marching beat. As the last vehicle passed by, it stopped for Santa Claus and his helpers to jump out and

mingle with the spectators, spreading their last minute holiday cheer.

Later, on Platt Field, Santa entertained children's last minutes requests while others viewed the static displays and swarmed over amphibious vehicles, trucks, artillery pieces and aircraft.

Other attractions were the helium balloon and ice cream stands, the "dogtag" manufacturing table, and the recon display area where many of the young visitors emerged with "cammied" faces.

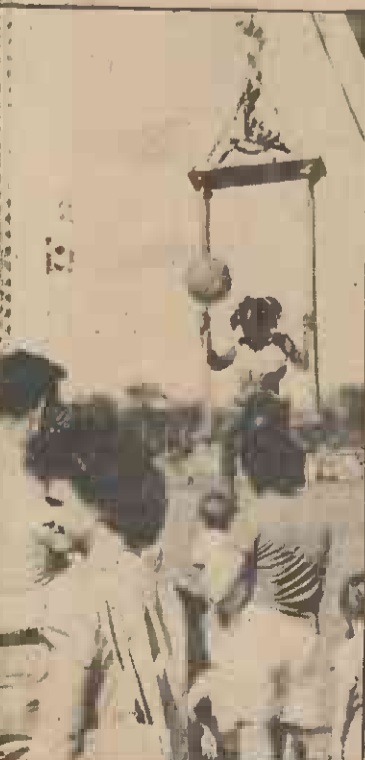

3d Marines' history

The history of the 3d Marine Regiment dates back to Dec. 20, 1916, when it was formed by consolidating Marine detachments from various ships in the Atlantic Fleet, then anchored in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Campaigns in Mexico and the Dominican Republic highlighted the early years of the regiment until it was redesignated a reserve unit in San Francisco, and ultimately disbanded in December 1937.

The outbreak of World War II brought the 3d Marines back into action. Reactivated at New River, N.C. on June 16, 1942, the regiment was instrumental in the Bougainville and Guam operations of the Pacific theatre.

Following World War II, the regiment saw duty in China, and was in training, here, in Japan and on Okinawa during the Korean Conflict. In 1965, the regiment moved to Vietnam, where it participated in 48 major operations.

After Vietnam, the regiment moved to Camp Pendleton, Calif., where it was part of the 5th Marine Amphibious Brigade, until April 1971 when it joined the 1st Marine Division. Two months later, the 3d Marines moved to their present home at MCAS Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii.

The 3d Marine Regiment, in addition to its accomplishments on the battlefield, is the largest infantry regiment in the Marine Corps, and is the only one with organic artillery, reconnaissance and amphibious assault elements. With these assets, the 3d Marine Regiment composes the ground combat element of the 1st Marine Amphibious Brigade.

Police educate motorists on drunk driving

The holiday season is a time when people are more likely to overindulge in alcohol. It is also a time when drinking drivers are more likely to be caught. On military installations and in civilian communities, police would much rather keep drunk drivers off the road in the first place; but they're ready to catch anyone foolish enough to drive after too much holiday cheer.

A variety of approaches are used to warn and educate motorists and to crack down on drinking drivers.

The Los Angeles City Police Department program of getting popular disc jockeys intoxicated under controlled conditions before they do their shows helps demonstrate the effects of alcohol. The department also has drunk driving exhibits in shopping centers, complete with Breathalyzers, where the curious can volunteer to be tested.

Other police departments are more traditional, such

as in Baltimore County, Md., and Dallas. These departments more than double their forces in high accident areas (where bars are concentrated) from shortly after Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day.



The Los Angeles police also increase their deployment at strategic places and times — such as weekday evenings, — when people are leaving office

parties, and during weekends.

Police officers George Gast, Baltimore County and Ed Spencer, Dallas, agree that local TV news helps by publicizing arrests keeping some potential drunk

drivers off the roads.

Law enforcement agencies also use acronyms and slogans. The Baltimore County Police slogan is HELP — for "Holiday Enforcement Lifesaving

Program," the Dallas counterpart is "Home for the Holidays."

At NAS Pensacola, Fla., drivers must negotiate an obstacle course of traffic cones to get off base. On Christmas and New Year's, and the days before and after these days, anyone who fails to negotiate the course must either get another driver or be prepared to spend the night on base. If they're uncooperative, they'll be booked on drunk driving charges.

Education is a big part of all anti-drunk driving campaigns.

Fort Belvoir, Va., stops cars at regular intervals, but this is nothing special for the holidays — they do it all year. What is special for the holidays is a class on drunk driving and safe driving that's available to every soldier. Last year, the

class was so popular it was given 18 times during the Thanksgiving through Christmas period.

Command support is a big part of the educational program. All of the military police interviewed cited the strong commitment on the part of base commanders to the anti-drunk driving program.

Also popular is the designated driver program. Most military clubs and a number of civilian establishments participate in this program, giving the designated driver of a group of three or more free soft drinks.

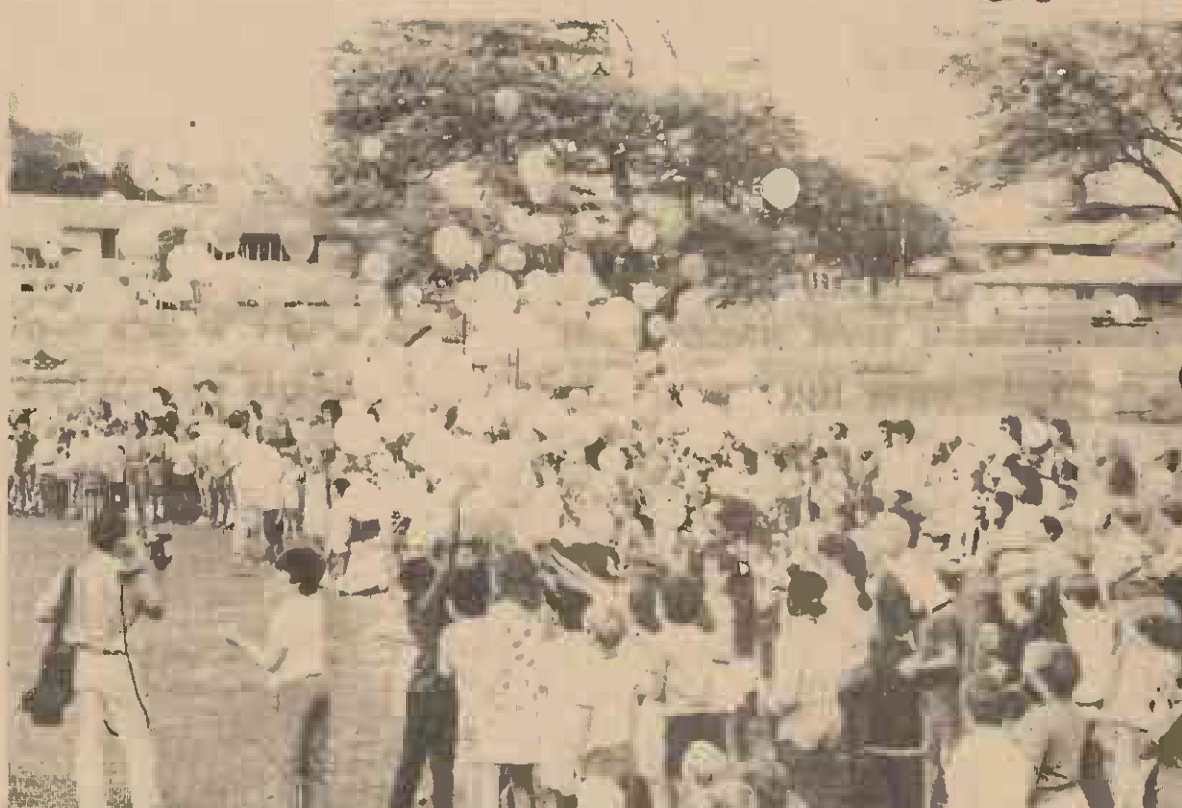
The students were given a form on which they listed the books they read and a place was put on the form where the parents signed for each completion. Each

Okinawa, Japan — The Marines of Co. L, 3d Bn, 3d Marines recently completed 11 days of field exercises and training at the Northern Training Area here to enhance their combat skills.

The Marines started their training with classes on land navigation, including use of the compass, terrain appreciation and map reading.

An extensive patrolling course followed, covering subjects such as security, actions at the objective, movement, and classifica-

tion of reconnaissance; and combat patrols.

The Marines also received instruction on supporting arms, learning how to identify targets, issue warning orders and adjusting fire on targets.

The final classes taught the Marines the different types of tactical reports used in various situations; the types of mines and booby traps used in the Marine Corps; and the tactics of armed conflict.

During the practical application phase, the Marines conducted an ambush, undertook a lengthy patrol, and had

rappelling, combat run and slide-for-life training.

"Many of our Marines and sailors have never had the opportunity to rappel or navigate obstacles in this type of terrain before," said 1stLt. Glen Wells, executive officer. "I'm sure many of our Marines will consider NTA training to be the highlight of our six-month deployment."

As for the Marines of Lima Company, they say it ended too soon.

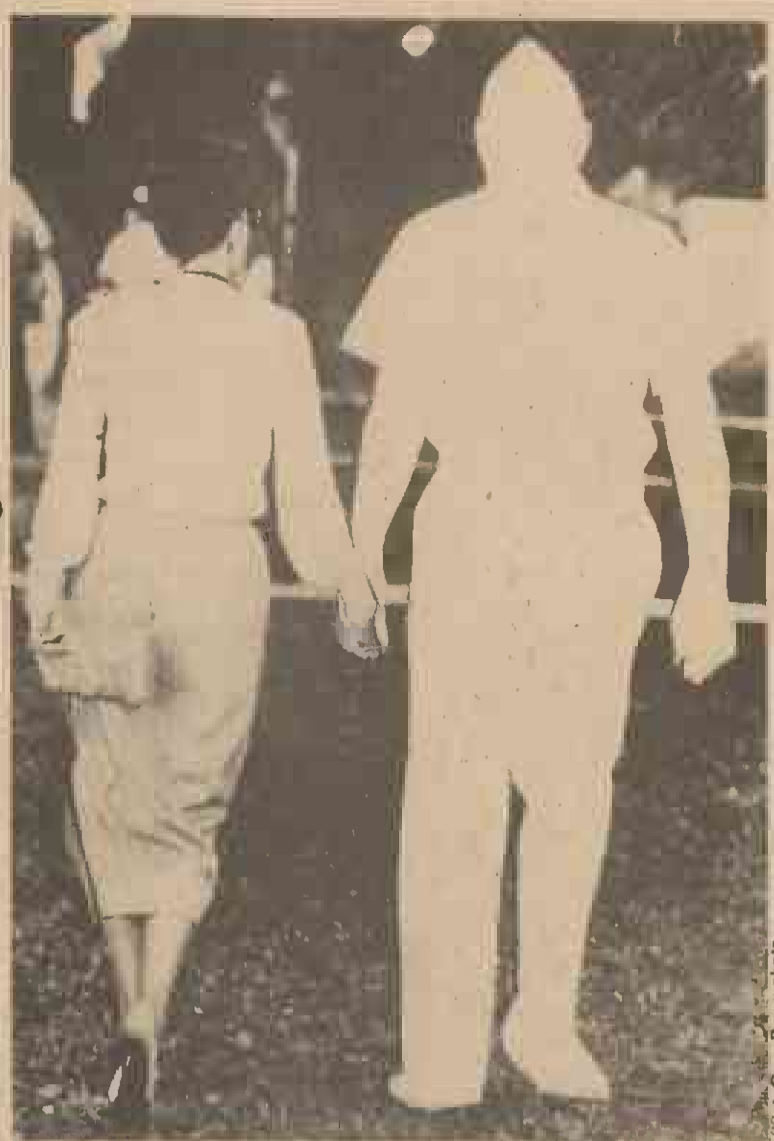

MAC flights: inexpensive, easy to get

Taking the famous Star Ferry from Hong Kong to Kowloon, or eating at Jumbo's Floating Restaurant in Aberdeen may conjure up images of high expense and a doubtful chance of doing it on a military budget.

Through the Military Airlift Command Space Available program, "expensive" trips could cost as little as \$20 for roundtrip fare.

"Many Marines don't take advantage of the MAC flights because they're just not aware of them," said Sergeant Earl Freeman, Marine liaison, Hickam Air Force Base Terminal.

"A person has to be on leave to sign up for a MAC flight," said Master Sergeant Ray Cundiff, NCOIC of the liaison team. "If a Marine wants to go on leave to the mainland, he would sign up to go to the U.S."

About 95 percent of the flights that leave here go either to Norton or Travis Air Force Bases in California. From there a Marine can try to catch flights throughout the mainland. "It might average about two or three days leave time, but that's still cheaper than the average fare to the mainland of \$238," said Cundiff.

There are several categories for traveling on MAC flights.

Category 1 travel is reserved for emergency leave servicemembers.

Category 2A is designated for sponsors on environmental and morale leave or dependents traveling with their sponsors on EML status.

Category 2B is for servicemembers, and authorized family members, on annual leave.

Category 2C is for unaccompanied EML dependents 17-years old or older.

Category 3 is for secondary school students who are members of a military family, and dependents of U.S., employees of DoD serving an accompanied tour overseas where there is no DoD overseas dependent accredi-

ed school at or near overseas locations.

Category 4 is reserved for retired military members, or Reserve or Air National Guard who have DD Form 2 and DD Form 1853, authorization for Reserve travel.

"Emergency leave is a different situation," said Cundiff. "If an individual is approved by his command, then he is issued a set of orders. If he's going to the mainland, and there are no MAC flights leaving for the west coast within three or four hours, we put him on a commercial flight." The Marine Corps will only pay the cost to the west coast, and back. It's the individual's responsibility to pay from there to his final destination.

"Many times, Marines need financial assistance," said Corporal DeSalle Holmes, another member of

the liaison team. "We try to set them up with the Red Cross to help them on their way." If they need transportation, the team tries to assist them in that area, too.

If a person is not on emergency leave status, the cost of the flight to his

destination can be as little as \$10 per person, and \$1.85 for meals if any are desired or available.
