
DESCRIPTION

Some customers may notice the rear A/C vent cover is loose / detached from the carpet, which may also be torn or damaged. This concern may be caused when excessive force is applied to the A/C vent cover clip, resulting in a loose or dislodged vent cover. To eliminate this concern, the clip position and configuration of the rear A/C vent cover have been changed to improve its durability.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Verify the customer concern.

2. Replace the carpet with a modified one according to the instructions on MGSS online (FLOOR COVERING REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).

NOTE:

- New modified carpet includes new modified A/C vent covers (K131-68-6D1 02).
- If vent covers become loose or detached in the future, replace the vent covers separately.
- New modified vent covers are not compatible with old carpet. New modified vent covers are only compatible with new modified carpet.
- The selector lever component and bracket do not need to be removed.

3. Verify the repair.
