SUBJECT: New Cascadia Incorrect ICUC Fuel Economy Reading

ISSUE

New Cascadia units built or updated to CPC3Evo software version R31.23 <u>and</u> equipped with a 3rd party telematics device may incorrectly display fuel economy only on the ICUC at elevated levels up to a maximum value of 99.9mpg due to a signal processing issue in the central gateway.

DDEC Reports will display mileage correctly.

REQUIRED ACTION

If a unit is brought in with this complaint – CPC3Evo software X31.53 has been released as test for use by the Customer Support Center in the interim until a production release is complete.

Please contact the Customer Support Center via normal methods (Phone, Web, or Email – Reference 14CSA17) with the request for this software and the server will be set.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

Once server is set after CSC contact, re-flash the CPC3Evo to X31.53. CPC3Evo is the only controller that needs to be re-flashed to correct this issue.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

Claim should be filed using **VIN only** as this is covered under normal OEM Warranty.
