# Betting Basics 

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager

Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:
1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
2 Number of the race
3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
4 Type of bet (see step 2)
5 Horse's number (see step 4)
Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse \#4

## How to use a self-serve terminal:

1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
2 Enter the initial PIN \#1234 (then choose a new PIN)
3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
4 Tap the Horse Number: \#4
5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: WIN
6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: \$2
7 Press/Tap the Race Number: Race \#6
8 Press Green "Make BET" button
9 Press/Tap the "Finish with Receipt" button
10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted
To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Win | UU | Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds. |
| Place | $\bigcup$ | Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show. |
| Show | $\bigcup$ | Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs. |

## Exotic multiple-horse bets

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Exacta* | $U \cup \cup$ | Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds. |
| Daily double | $\cup \cup \cup$ | Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races. |
| Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6 | $\cup \cup \cup U U$ | Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager. |
| Triactor** | $\cup \cup \cup \cup U \cup$ | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses. |
| Superfecta* | $\cup \cup \cup \cup U U$ | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible. |

How to read the program


All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

9 Horse's current record (\# of races, \# wins, \# of 2nds, \# of 3rds, and money earned)

## 4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

## Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the Television or in-field on the Tote Board before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

## Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the Television or Tote Board (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add $\$ 2$. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember
WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32\% of the time PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53\% of the time SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67\% of the time

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

\#2 DJIMON went winless in four tries at the age of two and made miscues in three of those contests. He put on the trotting hopples for his final two outings of that campaign and managed to stay on his gait for the first time on August 4th at 4-1 but then made multiple breaks in stride nearly three weeks later when only getting beaten by three quarters of a length at 13-1. This son of Tactical Landing will now make his sophomore debut and finished up strongly his most recent morning prep when finishing fourth, trotting his back-half in 56.1 with a final quarter in 27.2. He returns after a layoff of more than eight months and will have Bob McClure back aboard when racing without trotting hopples again this evening. Giving him the nod in the opener.
\#1 PESO HANOVER made up ground in the late stages last week to only miss by half a length to race-favorite Overpayment in third at odds of 13-1. He was more than eight lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting his back-half in 56.3 with a final quarter in 27.2 and should benefit from getting that start under his belt. This son of Walner tried his luck in the NJSS last season and has now hit the board in each of his two attempts in the overnight ranks here at Mohawk Park. He got the nod from Tyler Jones over another in the contest and will once again leave from the pole position.
\#5 ENZO AGUELLO was second best to Dahlquist Hanover last week at odds of 18-1 and was more than five lengths back of that rival at the finish. He will be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Stephen Bossence and has now hit the board in five of his nine career attempts. This son of Father Patrick will race back on a regular rotation this evening and should appreciate sliding in a few spots to leave from the center of the gate with post-five. He should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.
\#3 TITAN FLAX $S$ came from a long way out of it to be the runner-up on April 13th and was just a length away from longshot winner Barroom Brawl Boys at 2-1. He trotted home in 28.3 on the heels of a back-half in 56.4 and had a troubled trip one week earlier when finishing sixth at a much bigger price of 23-1. This son of Love You will move back to three-hole for tonight's tilt and can pick up a decent chunk with a favorable journey. He should not be excluded from the bottom end of the exotics.

## Race 2 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

\#7 MACH IMPACT converted off a perfect two-hole trip in this class last week and popped the pocket on the one below on the bend for home before pacing away to score by a clear margin in 1:54 flat. He has hit the board in two of his three tries since being claimed by trainer Gerard Demers for $\$ 7,000$ on March 23rd and will have his price tag hiked by another $\$ 500$ tonight but will have to move out another pair of spots on the gate to post-seven. This 29-time winner has been second or better in five of his eight starts after missing nearly a year of action and has two victories in seven on the board finishes in the 12 times that Jody Jamieson has been aboard. He looks like a prime candidate to double-up and gets the call on top.
\#5 THUNDERING JIM went a long way on the lead in his latest before watching the one above sail past him for the victory in the stretch. He chopped out reasonable fractions on the engine in the first three panels and was on the point at the three-quarter pole in each of his last two but faded back to fifth on April 13th. This 37 -time winner has been no worse than second in seven of his last 10 when carrying a price tag of $\$ 9,000$ and will once again leave from the center of the gate this evening. He will likely be looking to set up shop on the front-end and will take some catching.
\#8 ARTISTIC PICK made a first-over bid on the bend for home last week and picked up the cover of the winner before having to settle for the show spot at odds of $7 / 2$. He was breathing down the neck of the one above in the dying strides but was more than two lengths back of the winner at the wire. This 20-time winner has hit the board in each of his last three and has finished third or better in nine of his last 11 overall. He will have to overcome the outermost post for the second consecutive outing but can still hit the ticket.
\#6 HURRIKANEKINGCARLO has completed the superfecta in each of his last two when competing on the B-tracks and was second best to Just a Marvelous at The Raceway in London on April 10th in NW1500L5. He will be making his fifth start for Stew McQueen after that conditioner snagged home for $\$ 8,000$ on March 23 rd and does not look out of place against this group. This son of Artspeak picks up the services of top driver James MacDonald and can grab a share.

\#8 TEXACO MAN did not have much of a chance in his latest in NW4000L5 when he got away last off the gate from post-10 and was nearly 19 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was only able to improve one position after trotting his back-half in 56.1 with a final quarter in 27.4 and had missed a week between starts going into that effort. This 14-time winner will race for a claiming tag for just the second time in his career and should benefit from racing back on a regular schedule. He will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but has proven to be versatile in his racing style. Top call.
\#3 BELLA CAVALLA was second best to the one above on April 13th after vacating the pocket on the final turn and provided cover for that rival before having to settle for the place spot at 2-1. She has traded victories with that foe in each of her last three outings and has hit the board in eight of her last 10 overall. This daughter of Dover Dan has enjoyed a pair of victories over that span but might be giving up a fitness edge to the one above. She will leave from another favorable post position and should be in the mix throughout.
\#6 CLEVELAND MASSIMO has got to the winner's circle in three of his last five since returning to the races for his four-year-old season and has not been worse than second in any of those efforts. He converted as the 4/5 favorite two weeks ago after picking up the cover of the one above on the turn for home and only came up a head short of that rival two back when getting the same trip scenario. This son of Muscle Mass will likely take support at the windows again this evening and is among the main chances. He should land somewhere on the ticket.
\#7 FANCY EXPRESSIONS is an intriguing option after spending her last four outings at Western Fair and made a big recovery in her debut on Canadian soil on March 21st when she rallied to be second after putting herself in a deep hole with an early miscue. She has walked away empty-handed in her three subsequent tries over that half-mile surface but will now make the transition to the big track and will have Sylvain Filion at the controls for the first time. She might offer some value on the board and is worth keeping an eye on.





## Race 4 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.
\#6 LITE THE CANDLES could not have been a more dominant winner in his lifetime debut last week and scored by nearly eight lengths when tripping the wire in 1:57.2. He kept driving to the lead from post-nine in that contest before tripping the halfway marker in a soft 1:00.3 but then trotted home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 57 seconds flat. This son of Muscle Mass was under tight lines to the wire and will get to come right back for an encore performance in NW1. He has done everything right so far at three after making a miscue in his lone qualifier last season and is hard to go against. Giving him the nod to repeat at what figures to be a short price.
\#3 DEADLINE HALL disappointed at 50 cents to the dollar on April 13th when he had to settle for second to Eden Onthehill in his three-year-old debut. He had not raced in nearly six months going into that effort and has now had another week off between outings. This other son of Muscle Mass hit the board in four of 10 as a rookie and, including a third-place finish in the Super Final, and now has just under \$75,000 in career earnings. He should take a step forward this evening but will likely have to play second fiddle to the one above.

\#7 SOUTHWIND COORS went one for 11 at the age of two but hit the board in seven of those outings and was just shy of $\$ 89,000$ in earnings. He got his picture taken for the first time when going postward in NW1 last October and was picked up the bulk of his bankroll when finishing fourth in the Wellwood Memorial at 40-1 in August. This son of Walner was a winner in his lone qualifier in preparation for his return and will make his sophomore debut with a new pilot in the form of leading driver James MacDonald. He looks to have a promising three-year-old season on the horizon and is our clear choice on top.
\#1 ENOLA rallied into the place spot behind heavy-favorite LindysIrishcream last week at 15-1 and came home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 56.2. She has been no worse than third in her three tries at the age of three and has hit the board in 12 of her 15 career attempts so far. This daughter of Resolve will work from the pole position for the third consecutive start and will have Tyler Borth back at the reins. She has been knocking at the door at this level but might have to be the bridesmaid once again.
\#4 ROUGH TUFF TESTED was the runner-up to Eden Onthehill last week when going off at 9/2 and was two lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire after being overland for much of the journey. He trotted his back-half in 56.4 with a final panel in 27.1 and has now managed to hit the board in eight of his 10 lifetime tries. This son of Muscle Mass loses J-Mac to our top selection but picks up a familiar face in Doug McNair, who guided him to a second-place finish in the OSS Grassroots Final last October. He can hit the ticket.
\#6 LAST PAGE FIRST was a winner in the first start of her career last season when she went all the way on the lead in a NYSS event at Batavia Downs but then only picked up one minor award in her next three outings. She was only beaten by three quarters of a length in fourth to Tactical Planner in the final of the Pure Ivory over this surface and will now make her sophomore debut off a third-place finish in a qualifier on April 14th. This daughter of Chapter Seven will have Louis-Philippe Roy in the driver's seat for the first time and is worth keeping tabs on.

\#8 PREMIER BETTINA went a long way on the lead last Sunday night at Flamboro Downs but was picked up by a neck at the wire by Whatineedisaman. She has been the runner-up to that foe in each of her last two over two different surfaces on the B-tracks and has hit the board in each of her last four overall. This 15-time winner was plucked out of her latest for $\$ 13,000$ by top trainer Richard Moreau and will now compete on the big track for just the second time this season. She has been racing at the top of her game as of late and the addition of top driver James MacDonald should only further help her chances. Giving her our top honors in the nightcap.
\#10 NIMAH FRANCO N was handled aggressively in her latest when she secured the pocket off the gate and then angled out around horses in the stretch before scoring by a comfortable margin at the wire at 6-1. She has hit the board in three of her four outings since being claimed for $\mathbf{\$ 9 , 0 0 0}$ by conditioner Katelyn Graham and has finished third or better in six of her last seven overall. This 20-time winner will have to overcome the outermost post after having her price tag increased by $\$ 1,000$ for tonight's tilt. She has been in good order as of late and has enough early foot to get into a favorable spot off the switch.
\#9 SUNNY SICILY did not have much of a chance in her latest when getting away last off the gate from post-eight at Flamboro Downs in NW1500L3 and was more than 17 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. She had not raced in more than two weeks going into that effort after getting placed back to 10th from fifth for a pylon violation here at Mohawk Park on April 7th and will now be making her fourth attempt out of the barn of trainer Craig Gilmour. She picks up the driving services of Doug McNair for the first time and should not be taken lightly.
\#3 SWEET ROCKIN GIA has not gotten any respect on the board in any of her recent efforts but has managed to hit the board in five of her last six. She rounded out the trifecta at 48-1 last week at this level and was the runner-up in the claiming handicap class below two back at 26-1. This 22-time winner has come home in 27.1 in each of her last two but might get overlooked on the odds board again this evening. She should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.
\#4 BLACK BETTY exits the same race as our top selection and finished fifth in that contest at 7 - 1 after trying a wide move on the turn for home. She was the runner-up at 35-1 at that level at The Raceway in London two back and will now go postward for Isaac Waxman after that high-percentage conditioner grabbed her out of her latest for $\$ 10,500$. This 13 -time winner will be reunited with her now part-owner Louis-Philippe Roy in the sulky and can pick up a decent chunk when returning to Mohawk Park for the first time since last November.

## CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.
Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger
The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a $50 \%$ allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a $\$ 20,000$ claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50\% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25\% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January $1^{\text {st }} 2012$
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes
with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:
Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{leg}$ in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.


## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontar io Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called"Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.
All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and AgriFood Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/
All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.
No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.
A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.
No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of parimutuel pools.
Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.
ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS
"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.
"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field. DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)
A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.
Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012
EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA
An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. $1 \& 1 \mathrm{~A}$ and/or 2 \& 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.
JACKPOT H1-5
A Jackpot $\mathrm{Hi}-5$ bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi -5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 \& 1 A and/or 2 \& 2B), Jackpot $\mathrm{Hi}-5$ will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be $1^{\text {st }}, 3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}, 5^{\text {th }}, 6^{\text {th }}$
That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive $50 \%$ of the pool for that day. The other $50 \%$ will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, $100 \%$ of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.
PICK 3 \& PICK-4 BETTING
The Pick 3 \& Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 \& Pick 4 respectively.
Winning tickets for the Pick 3 \& Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

## PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.
If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.
PICK 3, PICK 4 \& PICK 5 SCRATCHES
In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.
However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.
REFUNDS
Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6 : at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded. COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)
In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.
FAIR START
If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.
LOST \& OLD TICKETS
WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.
For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.
ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY
The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission. WOODBINEIMOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place \& Show: $13.65 \%$. Trifecta \& Pick 4: 21.7\%. Double \& Exacta 17.2\%. Jackpot Hi-5 \& Pick 5: $11.7 \%$. All other $23.0 \%$

Horsepeople receive a further $2 \%$ on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is $4 \%$. The Ontario Provincial Government retains $0.5 \%$ on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains $0.8 \%$ on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
