# Cover Story

## Removing MTE Labels Makes a Big Difference

The U.S. Postal Service® collects, processes, transports, and delivers mail across the nation. Mail moves through the network in sacks, trays, and tubs. A “little” label identifies the destination for each container, which means a misplaced label can send the mail to the wrong destination.

Postal Service™ employees are responsible for removing all labels and tags from sacks, trays, and tubs when they empty the mail. The Mail Transport Equipment Service Centers do *not* remove labels or processing tags from Mail Transport Equipment (MTE).

Old tray labels must be thrown away, and any tags must be collected and reused as stated in the following excerpt from the MTE Standard Operating Procedure for processing facilities and delivery units:

“All tray labels must be removed as the tray is emptied of its contents. The label holder must be replaced with a new one if it has been damaged, torn, or has been rendered unusable in any manner. Once emptied, trays must be separated and stacked on pallets by type. All labels, placards, and residual signage (i.e., HAZMAT, Code Red, etc.) must be removed from all MTE when emptied.”

Our customers rely on us to correctly move and deliver mail. Old labels left in empty MTE increase the possibility of mistakes when this equipment is reused. Just the small act of “removing the label” can make a big impression on our mailers when they receive clean, useable MTE ready for their mail.

# Policies, Procedures, and Forms Updates

## Manuals

### DMM Revision: Affixing Postage

Effective March 4, 2019, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)*, in various sections to clarify the standards when a mailer is affixing postage to a mailpiece.

According to DMM section 604.4.0, Postage Meters and PC Products (“Postage Evidencing Systems”), the numerical value of postage displayed (in dollars and cents) on each mailpiece must be equal to or greater than the amount due for the applicable price and any extra service fees, or another amount permitted by mailing standards. Certain mailing standards allow a mailer to affix postage at less than the full price.

This DMM revision will clarify the standards when a mailer is affixing postage to commercial First-Class Mail® and USPS Marketing Mail®. This revision will also remove redundant text and provide consistency in the standards.

Although the Postal Service will not publish these revisions in the DMM until March 4, 2019, the standards are effective immediately.

### **234 Postage Payment and Documentation**

#### **1.0 Basic Standards for Postage Payment**

*[Revise the text of 1.0 to read as follows:]*

First-Class Mail presorted and automation postage must be paid with precanceled stamps, postage evidencing system indicia, or permit imprints. All pieces in a mailing must be paid with the same method unless otherwise permitted by standard or Business Mailer Support authorization. Permit imprints may be used for mailings of nonidentical-weight pieces only if authorized by Business Mailer Support.

*[Revise the title of 2.0 to read as follows:]*

#### **2.0 Affixing Postage to Presorted and Automation Letters and Flats**

*[Delete 2.1 in its entirety and renumber current 2.2 and 2.3 as new 2.1 and 2.2. Revise the text in renumbered 2.1 to read as follows:]*

#### **2.1 Affixing Postage for Presorted and Automation First-Class Mail**

Except as permitted under 2.2 or authorized by Business Mailer Support, each piece must bear the numerical value of postage under one of these conditions:

- Each letter-size or flat-size piece bearing a postage evidencing system indicium must bear the correct numerical value of postage for which the piece qualifies.
- Each letter-size or flat-size piece may bear a USPS precanceled stamp (or stamps precanceled with a mailer’s precancel postmark), under 604.3.0; postage documentation under 3.0 is required. Additional postage must be paid at the time of mailing with an advance deposit account or with a postage evidencing system indicium affixed to the postage statement.

*[Revise the title and text of renumbered 2.2 to read as follows:]*

#### **2.2 Affixing Postage at Less Than Full Price to All Pieces**

##### **2.2.1 Lowest Price**

A mailer may affix postage evidencing postage at the lowest price as follows:

- Letter-size or flat-size pieces:* A mailer may affix postage at the lowest eligible presort level and weight increment price in the mailing.

- b. *Additional postage:* Additional postage is computed based on the difference between the lowest price affixed to any piece in the mailing and the price for each price level in the mailing. The total additional postage must be paid either by advance deposit account or by a meter stamp affixed to the back of the accompanying postage statement.
- c. *Documentation:* The computation must be documented to meet the basic standards in 3.0.

**2.2.2 Mixed Price Alternative**

Where it is not practicable for the mailer to affix the exact postage to each piece or to affix the lowest postage price to all pieces in the mailing, the mailer may compute postage for the mailing as if the lowest price affixed to any piece in the mailing were affixed to all pieces. Additional postage is computed based on the difference between the lowest price affixed to any piece in the mailing and the price for each price level in the mailing. This computation must be documented to meet the basic standards in 3.0.

No refund is paid for any piece where postage is affixed at a price higher than the lowest price claimed for or affixed to any piece. The total additional postage must be paid either by advance deposit account or by a meter stamp affixed to the back of the accompanying postage statement.

To compute postage to be affixed to each piece/pound price piece, multiply the weight of the piece (in pounds) by the applicable price per pound; add the applicable per piece charge and any surcharge; and round the sum up to the next tenth of a cent. See 244.2.0 for affixing postage.

**244 Postage Payment and Documentation**

**1.0 Basic Standards for Postage Payment**

*[Delete the title of 1.1, Postage Payment Options, and move the text under 1.0. Revise the text of 1.0 to read as follows:]*

Postage for USPS Marketing Mail, including Customized Market Mail, must be paid with precanceled stamps, post-

age evidencing systems, or permit imprint as specified in 2.0. Unless authorized by the USPS under 705.2.0 through 705.5.0, or 705.16.0, when precanceled postage or postage evidencing systems are used, only one payment method may be used in a mailing. Mail manifested using the Electronic Verification System (eVS) under 705.2.9 must be paid with a permit imprint. Permit imprint may be used for mailings of nonidentical-weight pieces only if authorized by Business Mailer Support at USPS Headquarters.

**2.0 Additional Postage Payment Standards**

**2.1 Identical-Weight Pieces**

Mailings of identical-weight pieces may have, affixed to each piece, the exact numerical value of postage for which the piece qualifies, or postage at the lowest price applicable to pieces in the mailing, as stipulated under 3.0.\*\*\*

**3.2 Lowest Price**

A mailer may affix postage evidencing postage at the lowest price on identical-weight pieces as follows:

- a. *Pieces weighing 3.5 ounces or less for letters, 4 ounces or less for flats, or 3.3 ounces or less for parcels:* A mailer may affix postage at the lowest eligible presort level in the mailing.
- b. *Pieces weighing more than 4 ounces for flats or more than 3.3 ounces for parcels:* A mailer may affix the computed piece/pound postage (see 243.1.5.5) at the lowest eligible presort level in the mailing.
- c. *Additional postage:* Additional postage is computed based on the difference between the lowest price affixed to any piece in the mailing and the price for each price level in the mailing. The total additional postage must be paid either by advance deposit account or by a meter stamp affixed to the back of the accompanying postage statement.
- d. *Documentation:* The computation must be documented to meet the basic standards in 4.0.

## ELM Revision: Drivers' Phone Use Policy

Effective February 14, 2019, the Postal Service™ is revising the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), section 831.332, to include the policy that Postal Service employees must not use a cell phone while driving on duty.

Adding the cell phone policy to the ELM will put the manual in line with the policy in section 3-5.4, Motor Vehicle Safety Rules, in Handbook EL-801, *Supervisor's Safety Handbook*.

Although the Postal Service will publish this revision in the ELM at a later date, the standards are effective immediately.

### ELM Revision: Uniform Requirements

Effective February 14, 2019, the Postal Service™ is revising the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual (ELM)*, sections 932.11g and 932.22b, to reflect changes in uniform requirements.

Under revised section 932.11g, the type of postal retail personnel required to wear the prescribed uniform while performing work duties now includes postmasters at Cost Ascertainment Group (CAG) A-K Post Offices. Their official assignment must be at a retail counter for a minimum of 4 hours daily for 5 days per week on a continuing basis, or for not less than 30 hours weekly.

Under revised section 932.22b, Postal Support Employees (PSEs), upon conversion to career status, are not required to wait 90 days for uniform eligibility. They are considered present career employees in the regular work force who are assigned into a uniform category and have completed their 90-day probationary period.

Although the Postal Service will publish these revisions in the ELM at a later date, the standards are effective immediately.

### IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for the Philippines Updated

Effective February 14, 2019, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) to reflect changes to the Individual Country Listing for the Philippines.

In consultation with Philippine Postal Corporation (PHL-POST), the Postal Service published an article titled “IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for the Philippines” in *Postal Bulletin 22507* (11-22-18, page 7) removing the prohibition of “coffee in any form” and adding a restriction to allow a limited quantity of “liquid coffee, coffee beans, or ground coffee for personal consumption only.” In that article, we inadvertently included “liquid coffee.” However, after publication we obtained further clarification from PHL-POST about what type of coffee is allowed, so we are revising the wording under “Restrictions” to replace “liquid coffee” with “powdered coffee.”

## Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
  - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
  - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
  - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at [usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm](https://usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm).

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

**B.** Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

**B2.** All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

**C.** Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

**C1.** Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

**C2.** E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

**D.** Coffee is prohibited.

**E.** Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

**E1.** Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

**E2.** Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

**E3.** Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

**F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

**F1.** Weapons of any type are prohibited.

**F2.** Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

**F3.** Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

**G.** Parcels of any class are prohibited.

**H.** Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

**H1.** Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

**I.** Reserved for future use.

**I1.** Reserved for future use.

**I2.** Reserved for future use.

**I3.** Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 27 inches.
- Maximum width 14 inches.
- Maximum height 14 inches.
- Standard Post and Parcel Select parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

**K.** Reserved for future use.

**L.** All Official Mail is prohibited.

**M.** Fruits, vegetables, live animals, and live plants are prohibited.

**N.** Registered Mail service is prohibited.

**O.** Reserved for future use.

**P.** Official Mail only.

**Q.** Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

**R.** All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under Publication 52, Part 421, are prohibited.

**R1.** Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

**S.** Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

**T.** Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

**U.** Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

**U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

**U2.** Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

**U3.** Reserved for future use.

**U4.** Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

**V.** PMEMS is not available.

**V1.** Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on *USPS.com*. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.

**W.** Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

**X.** Cremated remains are prohibited.

**Y.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.

**Z.** No outside pieces (OSPs).

**Z1.** The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

## Finance

### Garnishment Administrative Fee Structure Change

Effective Pay Period 05-19 (Pay Date March 8, 2019), the U.S. Postal Service® will change the way it collects administrative fees from employees for processing creditor garnishments. Currently, the Postal Service™ charges an \$80.00 set-up fee for executing a garnishment. In the future, the Postal Service will charge \$6.00 each time a deduction is made from an employee's wages and monies are paid to the creditor. This change in the garnishment fee structure is a more equitable solution to the administrative fee burden placed on debtor employees and aligns closely with the current collection practices for child support fees and Treasury Offset fees.

The Postal Service is obligated to administrate, collect, and disburse monies subject to garnishment orders that are legally imposed upon Postal Service employees. The United States Code, 5 U.S.C. 5520a (j)(2), states that a federal agency's administrative costs in executing a garnishment action may be added to the garnishment, and that the agency may retain costs covered as offsetting collections.

Furthermore, the implementation regulation at 39 CFR Sec. 491.5 states that Postal Service administrative costs in executing the garnishment action will be added to each garnishment, and the costs recovered will be retained as offsetting collections. The Postal Service reserves the right to:

- Re-determine the administrative cost of any garnishment if, in administering the garnishment, extra costs are incurred beyond those normally encountered, and
- Add the extra cost to each garnishment.

The extra costs recovered will be retained as offsetting collections. The administrative costs will be collected from the employee upon whom the garnishment is served.

The stamp will go on sale nationwide on March 22, 2019, and must not be sold or cancelled before the first-day-of-issue.

The *Star Ribbon* stamp artwork features a digital illustration of a star made of red, white, and blue ribbon. The white space in the middle of the ribbon creates a second, smaller star. The tri-colored ribbon, folded into a patriotic symbol, is intended to evoke the connectedness of the American people. Greg Breeding was the art director. Aaron Draplin designed the stamp and created the artwork.

### Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

## How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at [usps.com/shop](https://usps.com/shop).

### Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches high by 4 inches long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail®.

### Traditional Postmarks

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail™. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

Locally produced items are not authorized. Only merchandise that has been approved and assigned an item number by Headquarters Retail Marketing may be produced and sold.

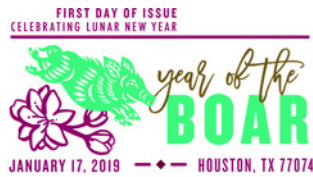

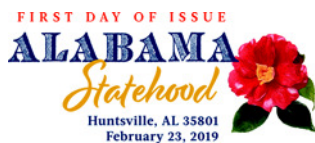

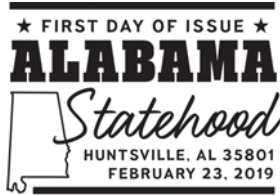
