There are those who would have one man appraise with one yardstick all the property in the county. That's more

ficers would all use a yardstick the same length. Supervisors have kept valuations low for several rea-
sons. Athough theoretically the amount of taxes should be no greater if spread upon high valuations than low, it has not
worked out that way. Taxing authoritics have levied the maximum millage.
But the place to lessen the tax burdens is in budgets,
not in assessments of property. By cutting appropriations, ax rates can be reduced so that the amounts to be papid wiil not grow greater even though spread over a broader base
Any assessing system which places all property upon assessment rolls at the same scale of values is satisfactory.
Equalization is to make sure that property owners in one township or city pay their fair share of county and school taxes.
