

# **Epic1 Enterprise (E1E) Training Registration Now Open for Super Users**

End User Training Registration Begins June 13

## E1E Training registration has begun to open:

- Monday, June 6, 2022 for Super Users
- Monday, June 13, 2022 for End Users

## **Registration Due Dates:**

- Friday, June 17, 2022: 50 percent of staff need to be registered
- Friday, July 1, 2022: 75 percent of staff need to be registered
- Friday, July 8, 2022: All staff need to be registered

Please note that reviewing the class schedule before scheduling staff ensures managers maintain adequate staffing. Additionally, classes should be completed in numerical order, e.g.: First complete "Registration Basics 100," then move on to "Patient Access 200." (*Please see RCM course charts in Q&A section, below.*)

Classes are offered Monday – Saturday from 7 a.m. – 10 p.m.

## What to Do Once Training Registration Opens

**Step 1:** When registration opens managers are asked to review the dates and times of Epic classes offered for their staff. Staff should be registered for the dates/time(s) that best meet department needs.

**Step 2**: There are two ways for BJC employees to be registered for classes.

- Epic1 Recommends: Managers register their team members in <u>Saba</u> (see <u>BJC Epic</u> <u>Registration Guide for Leaders, page 2)</u>
- Employees log in to <u>Saba</u> and register for the classes managers have approved for them to attend (see <u>BJC Epic Training Registration Guide, page 4</u>)

**Step 3**: If an employee needs a workstation to complete Epic1 training, spaces will be available at the following locations:

- AMH: Hatch Wing
- CH: CIS Computer Training Room, Detrick Building 4<sup>th</sup> Floor
- BJSP: CIS Training MOB 1 Suite 209 RM 209A
- PHC: Computer Training Room
- MBSH: Computer Training Room LL

## **RCM Operational Practice Labs**

Managers with team members who work in RCM or who schedule and/or register patients also need to sign them up for an **Operational Practice Lab** while registering them for their Epic1 classes. Information about the Labs will be sent to affected managers from <u>Krista Junge</u>.

## Q. By when do the trainings need to be completed?

**A.** Training takes place June 6 – September 16, 2022.

**Note:** In order to have access to Epic1 changes and new applications at go-live on September 24, 2022, *all required training must be completed by September 16.* 

Q. Are we offering OT for employees to take trainings outside of regular shifts?

**A**. Approval for overtime is at the discretion of each manager.

## Q. Do we have to meet the registration deadlines?

**A**. Yes, to ensure a seat is available for class, we highly recommend meeting the registration due dates.
