





Congratulatory Message to President Ford from Prime Minister Bandaranaike of Sri

Lanka--Action on Reply

The President has just approved language for replies to congratulatory messages on his assumption of office from world leaders. After the package had gone forward to the President, State informally recommended that a sentence be tacked on to the standard language for a reply to Mrs. Bandaranaike. I agree and this is to seek approval of a revised text.

The main point is that Mrs. Bandaranaike puts great stock in the personal touch. Since her visit to Washington and meeting with President Nixon in October 1971, she felt that she had established a personal rapport and our relations have improved since that time. In a far away place like Sri Lanka, the extra touch has great meaning. Also, from press reports, Sri Lanka officials are aware that President Ford sent certain leaders substantive messages on August 9, immediately after he assumed office. Mrs. Bandaranaike was not a recipient.

An amended text of the standard language would read as follows:

"Your thoughtful and heartening message of August 9 on my assumption of office as President of the United States is deeply appreciated. You may be assured that all the resources of the American Government will continue to be directed toward our common goal of a true and lasting peace for all mankind. I look forward to continuing the very friendly and cooperative relationship that has existed between our two countries at the highest level. With best wishes, Sincerely,

RECOMMENDATION: That the above revised reply to Mrs. Bandaranaike be approved.

Subject: Original Text of August 15 Message from President Ceausescu to President Ford

Attached for the record is the original text of the message to the President from President Ceausescu dated August 15, with an English translation. (There has been a subsequent letter from President Ceausescu to President Ford dated August 23, 1974, which was delivered August 27 personally to the President by Vasile Pungan, Special Envoy of President Ceausescu.) An initial copy of the August 15 letter was transmitted to President Ford by Ambassador Bogdan in a letter dated August 16, which mentioned that the original text would be forthcoming. The initial text and that attached are identical.

In light of the fact that the August 15 letter is in response to President Ford's message to President Ceausescu of August 9, and as the question of the invitation to the President to visit Romania mentioned therein was discussed during the Pungan visit and agreement in principle has been announced publicly, no further action is recommended.


