I limit the search for records to the DIA FOIA Office. I apologize for the delay in responding to your request as DIA continues its efforts to eliminate the large backlog of pending requests.

A search of DIA's systems of records located three documents (107 pages) responsive to your request.

Upon review, I have determined that some portions of the three documents must be released in part from disclosure pursuant to the FOIA while also taking into consideration of the foreseeable harm standard. The withheld portions are exempt from release pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6). Exemption 6 applies to information which if released would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of other individuals. DIA has not withheld any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the records.
