- Parents are welcome to drop by the home or center at anytime
- · Activities and materials excite the children and offer just the right amount of challenge
- Teachers are trained in child development or early education specific to your child's age
- · Warm and friendly adults are actively involved, talking and playing with children, rather than just watching them and telling them what to do
- · Indoor and outdoor spaces are clean, safe and well organized, with age appropriate equipment and a wide variety of well-maintained toys and educational materials
- Staff can explain to parents what skills their children are learning while they play



EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION

So Many Choices

There are many things to consider when choosing an early care and education program for your child. Programs are public or private, for-profit or non-profit, and differ regarding hours, fees, program options and staffing.

No matter what program your child attends, quality early care and education helps develop children's ability to learn, in addition to providing a safe, fun and nurturing environment.

What do Early Care and Education (ECE) programs look like?

CENTER BASED PROGRAMS

- Also called child care, daycare, preschool, nursery school or group child care.
- These programs provide ECE to 7 or more children in a classroom setting.
- Children under age three are in groups of 8 or less with at least one adult for everu 4 children.
- Children over three are in groups of 20 or less with at least one adult for every 10 children.

LICENSED HOME BASED PROGRAMS

- ECE provided in the licensed provider's home, sometimes called family
- Providers care for up to 6 full-time children and 3 school-aged children. Providers care for only two children under age two, unless the provider has an assistant.
- Some providers offer very flexible hours.

CARE PROVIDED BY A RELATIVE, BABYSITTER OR NANNY

• This type of care is currently not monitored by state or local officials.

LICENSING

- Center and home based programs are required to be licensed; public and parochial schools programs are exempt from licensing.
- For Child Care Licensing information call the CT Office of Early Childhood 1-800-282-6063.

ACCREDITATION

- Several national organizations offer accreditation to child care providers.
- Accreditation guidelines are generally stricter than those for licensing.
- Accreditation is voluntary and not required by state law.
