

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




Installation to Wood Stud Walls

A WARNING

- Installer must verify that the supporting surface will safely support the combined load of the equipment and all attached hardware and components.
- Tighten wood screws so that wall plate is firmly attached, but do not overtighten. Overtightening can damage the screws, greatly reducing their holding power.
- Never tighten in excess of 80 in. lb (9 N.M.).
- Make sure that mounting screws are anchored into the center of the stud. The use of an "edge to edge" stud finder is highly recommended.
- Hardware provided is for attachment of mount through standard thickness drywall or plaster into wood studs. Installers are responsible to provide hardware for other types of mounting situations.
- Use a stud finder to locate the edges of the stud. Use of an edge-to-edge stud finder is highly recommended. Based on its edges, draw a vertical line down the stud's center. Place wall arm (**A**) on wall as a template. Mark the center of the four mounting holes. Drill four 5/32" (4 mm) dia. holes 2-1/2" (65 mm) deep. Secure wall arm (**A**) to wood stud using four #14 x 2-1/2" wood screws (**E**) as shown. Skip to Step 3

Optional: Rotate wall plate 180° to position the arm closer to the ceiling.




Installation to a concrete or cinder block wall

WARNING

- When installing Peerless wall mounts on cinder block, verify that you have a minimum of 1-3/8" of actual concrete surface in the hole to be used for the concrete anchors. Do not drill into mortar joints! Be sure to mount in a solid part of the block, generally 1" minimum from the side of the block. Cinder block must meet ASTM C-90 specifications. It is suggested that a standard electric drill on slow setting is used to drill the hole instead of a hammer drill to avoid breaking out the back of the hole when entering a void or cavity.
- Concrete must be 2000 psi density minimum. Lighter density concrete may not hold concrete anchor.
- Make sure that the wall will safely support four times the combined load of the equipment and all attached hardware and components.
- Drill four 1/4" (6 mm) dia. holes to a minimum depth of 2.5" (64 mm). Attach wall arm (**A**) using four Alligator[®] anchors (**G**) and four #14 x 2 -1/2" wood screws (**E**) as shown in **Illustration A** and **1**, **2**, and **3**. Tighten all fasteners.






• Concrete anchors are **not** intended for attachment to concrete wall covered with a layer of plaster, drywall, or other finishing material. If mounting to concrete wall covered with plaster/drywall is unavoidable, plaster/drywall (up to 5/8" thick) must be counterbored as shown right. If plaster/drywall is thicker than 5/8", custom fasteners must be supplied by installer.





Installation to Wall Plate


Secure wall arm (A) to wall plate (K) using four carriage bolts (L) and lock nuts (M).



Installation to Wood Stud Walls



- Tighten wood screws so that wall plate is firmly attached, but do not overtighten. Overtightening can damage the screws, greatly reducing their holding power.

Place wall plate (K) on wall as a template. Mark the center of the four mounting holes. Drill four 5/32" (4 mm) dia. holes 2-1/2" (65 mm) deep. Secure wall plate (K) to wood stud using four #14 x 2-1/2" wood screws (E) as shown. Skip to Step 3.



Installation to a concrete or cinder block wall


- When installing Peerless wall mounts on cinder block, verify that you have a minimum of 1-3/8" of actual concrete surface in the hole to be used for the concrete anchors. Do not drill into mortar joints! Be sure to mount in a solid part of the block, generally 1" minimum from the side of the block. Cinder block must meet ASTM C-90 specifications. It is suggested that a standard electric drill on slow setting is used to drill the hole instead of a hammer drill to avoid breaking out the back of the hole when entering a void or cavity.
- Concrete must be 2000 psi density minimum. Lighter density concrete may not hold concrete anchor.
- Make sure that the wall will safely support four times the combined load of the equipment and all attached hardware and components.



Assembly of Adjustment Tube




Slide carriage (**B**) over wall arm (**A**), adjust to the desired projector throw distance as shown. Lock carriage (**B**) into place using four M5 x 10 mm screws (**D**).



Installing PRG Projector Mount (PSTA-028, PSTA-028-W)

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Installing PRG projector mount to wall arm assembly: Attach PRG projector mount (**J**) to carriage (**B**) using two 1/4-20 phillips screws (**H**) and two flat washers (**I**) as shown below.



Routing Cables



Routing Cables through PRG projector mount and wall arm assembly: Guide projector cables into openings in projector mount and wall arm assembly as shown below. Insert Tube Cap (F) into end of wall arm (A).

Note: Cables must be removed from projector before routing through wall arm.

Note: Follow projector mount (PRG) instructions to install projector.
