- Respond promptly to medical emergencies
- Respond promptly to trauma emergencies
- Determine patient's condition as well as pre-existing medical problems
- Attempt to stabilize the patient
- Transport patients to a hospital



What do Paramedics do?

- Administer drugs
- Interpret electrocardiograms
- Perform intubations
- Use monitors and other complex equipment

What is my employment outlook?

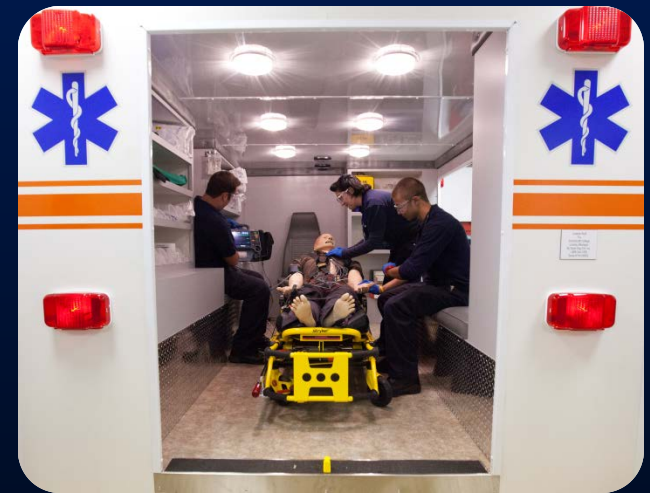
Employment opportunities for EMTs and Paramedics are expected to grow faster than the average for all occupations through the year 2015.

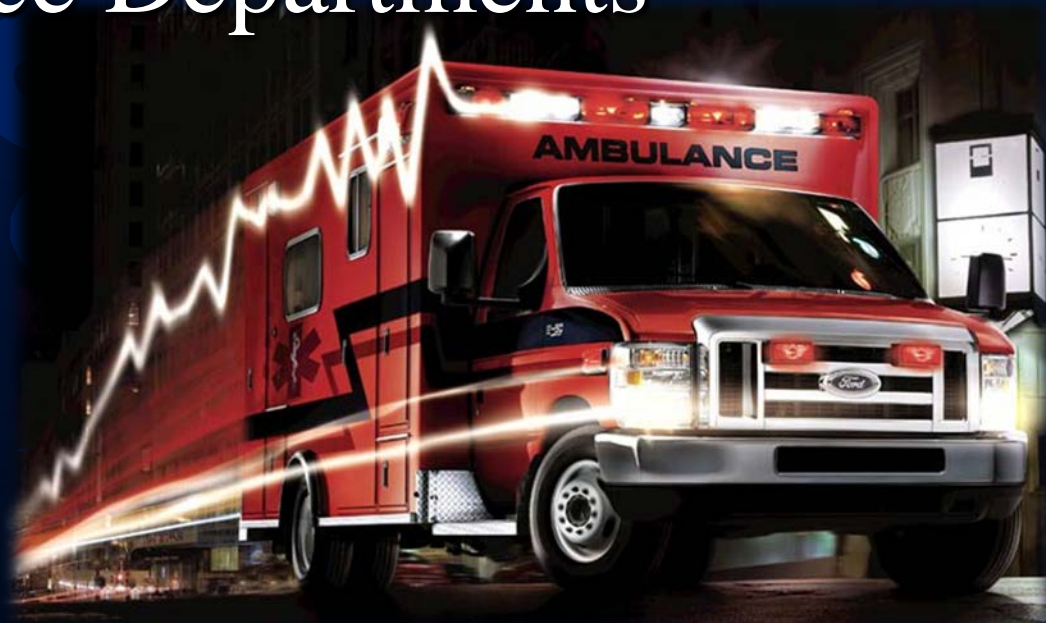
