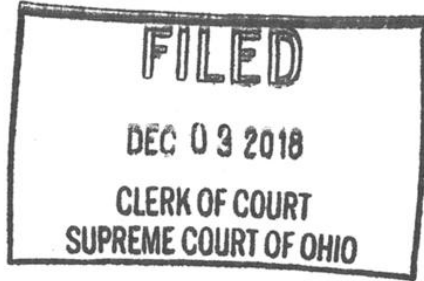

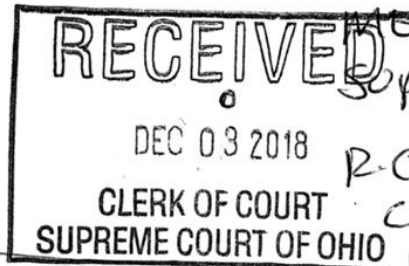

Statement of Facts: Ronald G. Johnson, inmate # A518-770 incarcerated at Northeastern Ohio Correctional Center in Youngstown is serving the definite prison sentences for the Second time as a result of the Bureau of Sentence Computations method to add definite terms "consecutively" to relators indefinite term. Imposing duplicate definite consecutive terms served two separate times; these duplicate consecutive definite terms violate the United States and the Ohio Constitution.

Relator respectfully requests the Honorable Supreme Court of Ohio to grant the Writ of Mandamus compelling the Bureau of Sentence Computation to add the 12-years of definite consecutive terms to the Minimum part of relators 7 to 25 year indefinite term (Montgomery County case # 86-CR-2584) in compliance with Ohio Revised Code Sentencing guidelines 2929.41 (Before 7-1-96); Aggregate term of 19 to 25 year sentence. Thus removing duplicate definite consecutive terms served two separate times.

Adjudicated Facts:

Ronald G. Johnson was sentenced to an 7 to 25 year indefinite term of incarceration

in Montgomery County, case # 86-CR-2584, on 2/23/8
 Per the Bureau of Sentence Computation, the 25
 year maximum term expired on 8/29/2012.

While on parole supervision release Johnson
 received 12-years of definite consecutive terms
 from Fayette County case # 05CR±0196; Adams
 County case # 20060006; Madison County case #
 2007-CR-03038 and case # 2007-CR-02018;
 Highland County case # 06-CR-134 And Montgomery
 County case # 2004-CR-2082. Per the Bureau of
 Sentence Computation, the 12-years of definite
 consecutive terms are served from 3/28/2006
 expiring on 6/14/2018 fully satisfying the Judgment
 orders of Common Pleas Courts.

* please note: the maximum part of the 7 to 25
 year indefinite term, Montgomery Co. # 86-CR-2584,
 does not stop being served even with new definite
 terms of imprisonment being served unless the new
 terms are... "Actual incarceration" or "Mandatory".
 None of relators definite consecutive terms are either
 Actual incarceration or mandatory.

The Bureau of Sentence Computation
 Added the 12-years of definite consecutive terms
 from Fayette Co. # 05CR±0196, Adams Co. # 20060006
 Madison Co. # 2007-CR-3038, Madison Co. #
 2007-CR-2018 And Montgomery Co. # 2004-

CR-2082 to the MAXIMUM expiration date of the 7 to 25 year indefinite term, Montgomery Co. #86-CR-2584. Imposing duplicate definite consecutive terms served from 8/29/2012 Expiring on 8/19/2024. After the expiration of all stated terms on 6/14/2018 only the fully served, expired definite terms incarcerate Ronald G. Johnson. Which are served for the second time from 6/14/2018 Expiring 8/19/2024.

Relator serves 74-months on expired fully satisfied
 Judgment orders from Madison Co. case# 2007-CR-2018
 (38 months total on 24-month sentence) and Montgomery

 Thus violating the United States and Ohio Constitution
 to impose two punishments on one criminal offense.
 These duplicate expired definite terms are only terms
 incarceration Johnson from 6/14/18 until 8/19/2024.

Constitution and Statutes:

The United States And Ohio Constitution Amendment Rights for Equal Protection, Double Jeopardy and Cruel And Unusual Punishment protect Against suffering the penalty of Any criminal offense more than one time. It is clear that the duplicate consecutive definite terms imposed by the Bureau of Sentence Computation violate both the U.S. and Ohio Constitutions by imposing 74-months of incarceration on fully served, expired, satisfied Judgment orders of the Common Pleas Courts.

The Ohio Revised Code sentencing guidelines before 7-1-96 specifically state how definite terms are to be served "consecutively" to indefinite terms. Ohio lawmakers designed the guidelines to Avoid duplicate consecutive terms. (R.C. 2929.41).

To serve 74-months on expired fully satisfied Judgment orders from Madison Co # 2007-CR-2018 (serving 38-months on 24-month sentence) and Montgomery Co # 2004-CR-2082 (serving 120-months on 60-month sentence) constitutes False imprisonment.

Relief Requested:

To compel the Bureau of Sentence Computation to produce documents that state the start And Expiration dates of all terms of imprisonment.

To compel the Bureau of Sentence Computation to produce documents with the start and expiration dates of all consecutive definite terms served from 8/29/2012 expiring on 8/19/2024; definite terms served consecutively to Montgomery Co. # 86-CR-2584

To provide all Judgment orders of Common Pleas Courts for Ronald G. Johnson A518-770.

Relief requested is to compel the Bureau of Sentence Computation to comply with the Ohio Revised Code 2929.41 (before 7-1-96) sentencing guidelines to Aggregate the Montgomery County # 86-CR-2584 7 to 25 year indefinite term with the 12-years of consecutive definite terms from Fayette # 05CR0196; Adams # 20060006; Madison # 2007-CR-3038 & # 2007-CR-2018 and Montgomery # 2004-CR-2082; Removing unlawful duplicate consecutive definite terms served for the second time from 6/14/2018 expiring 8/19/2024.

Relator will sign a release to protect the state, Dept. of Rehab & Corr and Bureau of Sentence Computation from any liability resulting from these duplicate sentences. I know there was no malice, just a mistake.

Pursuant to your request for sentence computation on the above offender, I can provide the following information.

Johnson was admitted on 2/27/1987 under offender number R140-163. He was sentenced to serve 7 minimum to 25 years maximum for the offense of Voluntary Manslaughter for Montgomery County Case Number 86CR2584. Per the sheriff's letter, 182 days was applied to this case. His first parole hearing was scheduled for 6/1991. His maximum expiration of sentence based on 25 years reduced by 182 days jail time credit was 8/22/2011. He was released on parole 4/12/1996, declared at large on 9/16/1996 and declared a technical parole violator on 9/24/1996. He was assessed 8 days lost time by the Adult Parole Authority which moved his maximum expiration of sentence date to 8/30/2011.

On 6/29/00, Johnson was admitted under offender number A394-072 due to a new felony committed while on parole. He was sentenced to 1 year firearm specification consecutive with 3 years for Having Weapon Under Disability, Montgomery County Case Number 2000CR00788. His parole was revoked and his numbers were aggregated. Pursuant to ORC 2929.14 (C)(1), the 1 year firearm specification was calculated as consecutive with the revoked parole violation case for a new maximum of expiration date of 8/29/2012. Johnson was paroled on 3/22/2004 and returned as a county jail parolee on 7/12/2005. Johnson went out to court and received added sentence Fayette 05CRI01096 which was committed while he was on parole. He returned from court on 3/28/2006 and was turned over to new number 518-770. Fayette was ordered consecutive to his current incarceration. The entry granted 2 days of jail time credit from which 1 day was deducted as his admission date was the same as the sentencing date. Johnson's parole was revoked and his numbers were aggregated.

On 5/31/07, Johnson was sentenced to 2 years on Madison 2007CR03038 with 0 jail time credit and 2 years on 2007CR02018 with 0 jail time credit which were committed while he was incarcerated under 518-770. These cases were ordered consecutive to each other and his current term.

On 6/27/07, he was sentenced to a total of 7 years on Highland 06CR134. He was granted 7 days jail time in the entry from which 1 day was subtracted as he returned the same day as sentencing. This case was ordered concurrent to his current offenses. At this time his controlling Expiration of Stated Term was based on the 7 years reduced by 6 days jail time credit for a date of 6/18/14. His Maximum of Expiration was computed on the 25 years for Montgomery 86CR2584 reduced by 182 days jail credit, 8 days lost time, the 1 year gun specification on Montgomery 2000CR00788 and the aggregate 7 years stated term on cases Fayette 05CRI0196 and Madison case 2007CR03038 and Madison 2007CR02018 for the date of 8/29/19.

On 8/23/07, Johnson was sentenced on Montgomery 2004CR02082. He was sentenced to a total of 5 years and was granted 360 days in the entry. This case was ordered consecutive to any other case the defendant is ordered to serve.

The 12 years aggregate sentence of 5 years on Montgomery 2004CR02082 consecutive to Highland 06CR134 controls his EST. The 12 years began on his return AWL date from Highland on 6/27/07 and was reduced by the 360 days for Montgomery Co. 2004CR02082 and 6 days for Highland 06CR134 for an Expiration of Stated Term of 6/22/18 which is currently 6/17/2018 due to receiving 5 days earned credit. His Maximum of Expiration date is based on the consecutive terms of 25 years maximum for Montgomery 86CR2584 reduced by 182 days jail credit, 8 days lost time, the 1 year gun specification on Montgomery 2000CR00788 and the 12 years aggregate sentence of consecutive cases Fayette 05CRI0196 (3 years); Madison 2007CR03038 (2 years); Madison 2007CR02018 (2 years); and Montgomery 2004CR02082 (5 years) for a computed date of 8/26/2024 which is currently 8/21/2024 due to the 5 days earned credit earned during the consecutive Senate Bill 2 cases. The jail time credit for the stated terms consecutive with his parole violation was not applied as jail time credit to his maximum expiration of sentence as these crimes were committed while on parole or in prison and would be duplicated credit. His first hearing date under 518-770 is scheduled for his Expiration of Stated Term date.

order of trial court at expiration of the
MAXIMUM 25-year term.

As B.O.S.C. Auditor Lora Heiss documents
indicates, Fayette County case no. 05CR10196
started on 3/28/2006. (Adams County case no.
20060006 is concurrent with Fayette County term)
these 3-year terms expire on 6/3/2009 with
13-days credit of jail time from Adams County.
Madison County case no. 2007CR03038 and
Madison County case no. 2007CR02018 are
served from expiration of Adams Co. on
6/3/2009 expiring on 6/3/2013.

AS B.O.S.C. Auditor Lora Heiss document indicates, the Highland county case no. 06CR134 term controls the Expiration of Stated Term (E.S.T.) with the Montgomery county case no. 2004 CR 2082 being served after it expires on 6/21/2014. Montgomery county case no. 2004 CR 2082 was credited with 360-days of jail credit and expired on the 6/14/2018 four years of state prison confinement. In 2015 at the date of Auditor Lora Heiss Adjudicated document, Ronald G. Johnson's Expiration of Definite terms was 6/17/2018. Johnson's earned days of credit reduced the Expiration of stated term to 6/14/2018. This 12-years of state prison confinement fully satisfied All trial court Judgment orders.

(1.) Montgomery county case no. 86 CR 2584, started on 2/23/1987; Expired on 8/29/2012 Fully satisfying the trial courts judgment order

(2.) Fayette county case no. 05 CR 10196, started on 3/28/2006; expired on 3/28/2009 Fully satisfying the trial court judgment order

(3.) Adams county case no. 20060006, started on 6/16/2006; expired on 6/3/2009 with 13 days of jail credit. Fully satisfying the Judgment Order.

(4) Madison County case no. 2007CR03038, started on 6/3/2009; expired on 6/3/2011 Fully satisfying the Judgment order of trial court

(5) Madison County case no. 2007CR02018, started on 6/3/2011; expired on 6/3/2013 Fully satisfying the Judgment order of trial court

(6) Highland County case no. 06CR134, started on 6/27/2007; expired on 6/21/2014 with 6-days of jail credit, fully satisfying Judgment order

(7) Montgomery County case no. 2004CR2082, started on 6/21/2014; expired on 6/14/2018 with 360-days of jail credit Fully satisfying the Judgment order of trial court

Ronald G. Johnson was eligible for Parole on 6/14/2018 which is admissible evidence as to the Factual merit proof of All terms of 12-years of Aggregate consecutive and concurrent definite terms being expired which fully satisfy the Judgment orders of Trial Courts.

II - Bureau of Sentence Computation imposed TWO punishments on all 12-years of Aggregate consecutive definite terms.... Starting from the maximum 25-year expiration date of Montgomery County case no. 86CR2584 on 8/29/2012 & Expiring on 8/19/2024

These 12-years of Twice imposed punishments on One Judgment Order of trial court violate the Ohio and United States Constitutions (O CONST. 1:10; U.S. CONST. AMT V).

AS Auditor Lora Heiss documents indicate, the Duplicate 12-years of aggregate consecutive definite terms are Added to Montgomery County case no. 86CR2584 starting on 8/29/2012:

- ① Fayette County case no. 05CR10196 (3-year)
Adam County case no. 20060006, 3-year IS served with it concurrently; Expires 8/29/15
- ② Madison County case no. 2007CR03038 (2 year); Expires on 8/29/2017
- ③ Madison County case no. 2007CR02018 (2-year); Expires on 8/29/2019 as the document verifies
- ④ Montgomery County case no. 2004CR2082 (5-year); Expires on 8/19/2024 without any jail credit as Auditor indicates the 360-days of jail credit would be "Duplicated" credit.

B.O.S.C. has unlawfully enhanced the Montgomery County case no. 86CR2584 with 12-years of aggregate consecutive terms that violate the Ohio and United States Constitutions imposing Two Terms of imprisonment on One Judgment Order of Trial court.....

III. B.O.S.C. has imposed 74-months of state prison confinement on fully satisfied Judgment Orders of trial Court; starting on 6/14/2018 expiring on 8/19/2024:

(1.) Madison County case no. 2007CR02018, 2-year term was satisfied with 24-months of state prison incarceration starting on 6/3/2011 expiring on 6/3/2013 per B.O.S.C. Records. B.O.S.C. has imposed an additional 14-months of state prison confinement on this term beginning on 6/14/2018 expiring on 8/29/2019. B.O.S.C. duplicate Twice imposed punishments impose 38-months of day for day incarceration on the 2-year Judgment Order.

(2.) Montgomery County case no. 2004CR2082, 5-year term was satisfied with 360-days of confinement in the Montgomery county jail (Awarded in Judgment order) And four (4) years of state prison confinement starting on 6/2/2014 expiring on 6/14/2018. B.O.S.C. has imposed an additional 60-months of state prison incarceration on this Judgment Order with the Duplicated Twice imposed terms; beginning on 8/29/2019 expiring on 8/19/2024. No jail time credit awarded. Imposing 10-years of incarceration on this Judgment Order

TO FALSE imprison Ronald G. Johnson for 74-months on fully satisfied Judgment orders violate the Ohio and United States constitutions. (4th 5th 6th 8th 12th & 14th).

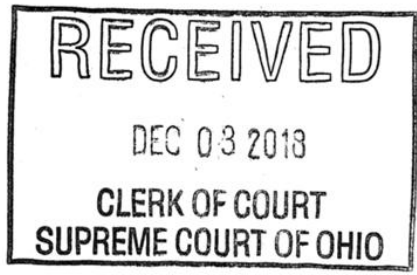
