Investigation established there was Insufficient Evidence to determine whether the offenses of Assault and Mistreatment occurred against Local Iraqi National by U.S. Forces. SGT reported that he witnessed several counter-intelligence (CI) agents strike, pull the hair, and force into asphyxiation numerous Iraqi detainees. SGT further stated some of the CI agents would point a loaded weapon at the detainee's heads and tell them they would kill them if they did not talk. Subsequent investigation did not identify any witnesses to the incident.



THE BEHAVIOR AND DEMEANOR OF ALL THI INTEROCATORS WAS AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF PROFESSIONALISM AT ALL TIMES. SPECIFICALLY, REFARDING THE SCREENING INTEROCATION OF THE IRACT DETAINEE KNOWN AS I WITNESSED CONCERN ON THE PART OF THE PRIMARY INTEROGATOR TOWARDS PREVENTING THE DETANCE FROM GOING INTO AMEDICAL CRISIS AS A RESULT OF THE QUESTIONING. HE STOPPED THE QUESTISHING SEVERAL TIMES SO THAT A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL COULD EXAMINE HIM AND DETERMINE IF HE WAS STILL DOING FINE. ALL ENDICATIONS WERE THAT, ASIDE FROM THE STRESS OF BEING CAPTURED AND QUESTIONED, HE WAS SUFFERING NO HEALTH CRISIS. DURING THAT INTEROGATION, AS WELL AS ALL OTHERS THAT I WITNESSED, THERE WAS NO VIOLENCE, OR THREAT OF VIOLENCE COMMUNICATED TO THE DETAINEE.

AS TO THE MOTIVE OF THE INDIVIDUAL MAKING ALLEGATIONS, I CANNOT SPEAK, BECAUSE I DIDN'T KNOW HIM WELL. I HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE OF ANY PROFESSIONAL OR PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP ISSUES BETWEEN THE INTEROCATOR, AND THE PERSON MAKING ALLEGATIONS, ASIDE FROM THE FACT THAT THE INTEROCATOR, BEING THE TEAM SELGEANT, RELIENED THAT INDIVIDUAL FOR CAUSE. I DO NOT KNOW THE REASONS FOR THE RELIEF.





A: Pretty much after our first attack, they began to escalate. The prisoners would get their hair pulled, be thrown into walls, etc. and they escalated over a period of time. Eventually, there were staged executions, intense physical duress and being forced into asphyixiating positions.

Q: Describe the physical duress?

A: Leaning on the prisoners chests with their knees, pulling their arms, physically striking them. Forcing the prisoners on their knees and ordering them to lean over until they couldn't breath. That actually caused respiratory arrest on four occasions, the prisoner's collapsed and quit breathing.

Q: Did you perform CPR?

A: No, I did a diaphram push on their chest, enabaling their breathing to begin again.

Q: What do you mean by staged executions?

A: The interrogators would hold a weapon to the prisoner's head, chamber rounds, threaten the prisoner's life.
