



The nights are turning darker and colder, which can only mean one thing; like it or not, the festive season is upon us. Some people I know have already completed their Christmas shopping. But if you move away from the gifts, this time is a period of reflection and empathy. Covid still lingers, despite losing some of its effect on us compared to last year. This year will be a little different.

We still remember what it was like; not seeing family or braving the cold to do a drive-by instead of going inside. It brought humility to us all. That should still be the case this year. Now, issues requiring empathy are still relevant.

Homelessness is one of them. According to official government statistics, "11,580 single households were assessed as rough sleeping at the time of the approach (2020-2021), up 39.4% from 2019-20." Covid and unemployment caused a lot of that, but it still isn't a happy statistic. We have all walked past a homeless person and not glanced at them. They feel unseen and lonely, which only adds to their distress. Their unhappiness is also added to by societies anti-homelessness policies; such as limiting covered bus shelters and benches, as well as restaurant policies being to throw out leftovers rather than giving them away.

Empathy goes a long way, and you can help in small doses. If you don't feel comfortable giving small change physically, gift them with food, drinks, blankets and resources. There have been plenty of stories of barbers giving out free haircuts or vets giving out free check-ups for homeless pets.

NE Offers and LNER are supporting the charity North East Homeless to put on a Christmas Eve lunch for the homeless in Central Station. You can indirectly help by donating £5 to the charity to provide a lunch for a vulnerable or homeless person, which may be the only gift they get this year.

Should the fundraising total more than they need on the day, the charity will provide the following for service users this winter: a pair of thermal socks and gloves, a toiletry pack, a mental health chat either by phone call or face to face, a food parcel, re-heatable meals made in the Hub, and a travel pass for someone who needs support or access to training/work experience. When asked to comment on their event, NEH said, "We started the Christmas Eve meal about four years ago. I wanted somewhere iconic but covered over. So I thought of Central Station. LNER have been brilliant in supporting us. Christmas is about looking after each other, and that's what NEH is all about. Loneliness is massive at Christmas time, hence why you don't have to be homeless to come to our meal."

Another charity helping the vulnerable is Feeding Families North East, which creates food parcels for those in need. You can donate by adding to their food banks or just fundraising for them in general. Recently, they shared the story of a young girl in Blyth who put up posters to support the charity and asked for food donations. This charity puts out an average of 1,000 food boxes every month. That figure alone shows how many vulnerable people rely on them. And with the increasing food and fuel prices, isn't that relatable?

In addition, Tyne Valley Express have partnered with a local photographer to produce a 2022 calendar. All of the proceeds will go to Feeding Families. Featuring beautiful seasonal images from Derwent and Tyne Valley, it's only $\pounds 9.99$ plus delivery.

Other issues have been in the media spotlight these last few months as well.

Conversations on animal welfare and kidnappings were rampant during the pandemic. Charities like Newcastle Dog and Cat Shelter had to adapt to the times. Soon their Christmas campaigns will be released, which will centre, as they do every year, on the fact that a pet isn't just for Christmas. They are, in fact, a lifelong family member. Adoptions skyrocket during the Christmas period, but they are soon handed back during the new year. They've also noticed a decrease in the number of cats being adopted compared to the dogs. New dogs, cats, and even a goat are added to their website every week. So, if you think you can give one of them a loving home, check out their website.

Another major issue, kicked off by the Sarah Everard case and the recent media backlash on the subject, is women's safety. A new charity that has popped up in Newcastle is Women's Street Watch NCL. Created in September, they have amassed 6K likes on Facebook and thousands of people want to volunteer for the charity. They want to patrol and create safe spaces for women in the North East and are looking for suitable function rooms to hold training sessions. They promote helpful messages and highlight those lives lost tragically by violence.

Christmas is a time to reflect, and charities rely on that for their promotion and donations. I want to promote them now so that if you choose to contribute, you can prepare with plenty of time to spare.

If you choose to help globally, there are plenty of charities to pick. Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas allows you to create shoebox hampers for refugees and vulnerable families in Africa. There are also local charities, which have popped up to support Afghanistan refugees.

But the concept of keeping things local has stayed with us well throughout the pandemic.

Four local charities feature in this article, centred on topics I care about, but there are tonnes more around the Tyne Valley and North East area. Giving a little goes a long way for those in need. Stop in on your local church or charity, volunteer for a weekend or hand out fliers. Every little bit helps.



As this year has progressed, I've seen an increase in people I work with, either through 1-2-1 work or attending my classes, who are seeking help due to feeling completely overwhelmed mentally and emotionally by life. A sense their head is full, clouded, forgetful and an inability to concentrate or sleep well seem to be the most usual complaints.

One of them most common factors for this is that we are in a state of Doing. Our mind creates a sense of urgency within our Doing state by telling us stories like- "you need to do this," "this has to be done", and the good old carrot and stick method of "once you do this, then you can take a break/rest.", that one is my personal favourite, as we all know, how many of us actually take the break/rest we promised ourselves?

The next common factor is that we are Head-led. This means we rely heavily on our head to do all the thinking for us. When we do this, we are not only adding more "traffic" to our already overburdened and over stimulated mental processes, but we are also filtering, or in some cases not filtering, our thoughts through the egoic mind. The Ego, our lower consciousness, is home to our Inner critic, limiting beliefs and programmed core beliefs about ourselves and the world around us, leading to feelings of shame, guilt, self-judgment, self-rejection, and low self-worth.

To understand what this does to us, imagine having a completely sedentary life with the exception of only exercising your bicep muscles for hours every day. No other muscle groups are exercised. We can say that you would definitely have beautifully toned biceps, but what would the rest of your body look like? It would more than likely be flabby, saggy and you would even see muscle atrophy in non-used muscle groups. In truth, you would never be able to exercise your biceps like this. It would result in muscle injury, joint inflammation and muscle fatigue which would translate to the overwhelmed, clouded, and forgetful mind states we experience when we are in a heavily Head-led-Doing state.

So how do we find balance and heal this state?

We find time daily to connect to our state of Being, the passive non-doing state. The Being state is accessed by developing an awareness of our state of presence and resonance. It is through this awareness that we are able to take the conscious action of stepping out of thought stream, dis-entangling from the minds' narrative of urgency and stepping into the quietness and stillness of our Being state. It is the changing gears from Head-Led consciousness, the Doing state, to Heart- Led consciousness, the Being state.

Heart consciousness is a practice of reconnecting energetically with the power of your heart's inner wisdom: your Intuition. When you listen to your intuition your mind, body and heart will go back into balance and guide you back to your authentic Self. Surrendering to your Heart consciousness is the practice of reconnecting what is already inside of you, your soul, your Being.

The work of reconnecting back to your heart's wisdom is such a powerful part of healing and has been documented for centuries. Ancient scriptures all point to one truth, that true wisdom comes when we turn to Heart Wisdom, our Soul, for guidance. Soul and Head work closely together in making decisions, guiding us through challenges, with Head acting as council but Soul taking the led, hence the terms Heart-Led or Leading

from the Heart. Reconnecting back to this heart-centred place takes practice just like anything else. To bring your attention inward and connect with the power of your heart, you practice Being, sitting quietly in stillness, and asking the heart wisdom what it needs from you.

In our mindfulness classes we are currently focusing on cultivating Presence, a practice of finding stillness daily to harness the connection to Heart consciousness as you learn to be in flow with your state of Being.

To practice this technique, try this-

- Take time to sit quietly for 10 mins a day. Make sure that there are no distractions, phones and gadgets turned on silent, no tv, radio, magazines, or books.
- Find a comfortable spot to sit. This can be on your bed, couch, kitchen table, in the garden, on a park bench, in the forest or on the beach.
- Set your timer to go off after 10 mins so you are not distracted by looking at your watch.
- As you sit, notice the sensation of your body sitting, notice the sounds, notice objects in your environment. Let go of whatever you notice
- Give yourself to just permission to experience each moment, and to Be in that moment.

Some benefits from this practice-


- Step out of the stream of thinking and helping you to befriend the mind
- · Improves connection with ourselves, others, and world around us
- Allows you to bring Presence to relationships, no matter how challenging they are
- · Helps bring balance within our Being vs Doing states
- · Improves mental clarity and cognition
- Downregulates the stress response, reducing anxiety
- Helps you let go of things
- · Helps build healthy relationship with emotions
- It is a profound act of Self-care

Profound healing is always possible when we meet ourselves first and foremost with an open heart and then extend that kindness and compassion to the world around us.

Almost everyone by now has heard of Bitcoin and the various other Cryptocurrencies, often referred to as "alt coins". But what is Bitcoin and the thousands of digital currencies all about, and why have they become so popular in the thirteen years since the Bitcoin white paper was published in October of 2008?

The Great Financial Crisis or GFC of 2008 led to many people questioning the Central Banking system and its unbacked fiat currency (or petrodollar system). People really started looking at the nature of money and what currencies actually were. So the GFC led to an awakening and the launch of Bitcoin, in hindsight, is not surprising.

According to Wikipedia: "Bitcoin is a decentralised digital currency, without a central bank or single administrator, that can be sent from user to user on the peer-to-peer Bitcoin network without the need for intermediaries. Transactions are verified by network nodes through Cryptography and recorded in a public distributed ledger called a blockchain. The Cryptocurrency was invented in 2008 by an unknown person or group of people using the name Satoshi Nakamoto. The currency began use in 2009 when its implementation was released as open-source software".

The goal behind Bitcoin is to replace Central Banks and flat currencies and become a form of digital gold.

How is Bitcoin created and how does it derive its value? The creation of Bitcoin is called mining and it is basically done through solving complex mathematical problems that were set up in the white paper. These mathematical problems become harder to solve with time as more Bitcoins are "mined" or created. The other factor that has led to the rising value of Bitcoin from less than \$1 to a present level of about \$60,000 is that the supply of Bitcoin is limited to 21,000,000 coins and can never be increased or changed. This limited supply is one of its strongest selling points as it is diametrically opposed to the inflationary nature of the fiat currency regime that we have had since 1971.

So what are the alt coins or other digital currencies all about? They evolved from the Bitcoin idea. The tech savvy software developers took the idea of Bitcoin and tried to improve on it and give these alt coins more than just a monetary and transfer of value function. They have, and continue to, create Crypto currencies with smart contracts and building open-source applications based on the blockchain. The blockchain is essentially a combination of all the blocks that have ever been mined or

created and they are always linked to each other and present in the open ledger - so everyone can see what has gone on since the inception of all Crypto currencies. Unlike Central Bankers' secretive actions, Bitcoin and Crypto currencies are open and transparent and the worldwide community of coders, miners and participants have evolved into a natural policing mechanism.

Thousands of white papers and alt coins have popped since the creation of Bitcoin and the great majority of them have been a failure as they have been unable to create the network effect and therefore not delivering what they promised. The general marketing idea of these alt coin projects is that they will transform an old business or industry by helping it decentralize and become more transparent by using the blockchain. The most successful of the alt coins so far is Ethereum and the basic idea behind this digital currency is that it evolves a step further than Bitcoin by allowing its users to build smart contracts on its network or blockchain. A lot of the alt coin projects such as e-sports, online gaming, Airbnb type apps, have used the Ethereum blockchain to build their projects.

So what are the pitfalls or drawbacks of Bitcoin and digital currencies? We would say that the fact that it is a decentralised system with no controlling authority makes it as close to a free market as possible but on the other hand gives it also a Wild West Environment of lawlessness. Despite the fact that Bitcoin and most alt coins are transparent and technically incorruptible, the eco system of exchanges, banks and projects that have mushroomed around it is rife with greed, dishonesty and all other negative human traits that permeate in all other sectors of society and the economy.

My advice to novices and those looking to get involved in Crypto currencies is to start from the basics and learn all about the digital wallets, the exchanges and the particular currencies you are interested in. Most alt coins worth their salt will have a white paper open to the public so there is no excuse for not doing your due diligence. It is imperative, in my opinion, that one should be prepared for huge price swings or volatility so leveraging or borrowing money to buy Cryptos is a double-edged sword. Earlier this year Bitcoin traded to around \$64,000 only to drop below \$30,000 a few months later in July. Likewise by the time you read this article, it may well have soared to \$100,000.



As a child I was besotted with the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. Feeling the fur coats brush my face as little hands maneuvered their way to the back of gran's old wooden wardrobe was always a welcome weekly adventure. God knows how long I stood there. Naturally the entrance to Narnia remained eternally elusive yet I never stopped believing. Whenever I see an old fashioned street lamp my soul always remembers and smiles, maybe this time?

"You have returned for reason. Your adventure begins now."

So imagine my delight when some considerable decades later I enter the magical world of Narnia for real. In my previous article 'The Holy Ghost' I shared a series of miraculous experiences I had with a wild white roebuck in woodlands local to my home. The White Hart whose appearance is synonymous with the delivery of a message exists across all cultures, myths and religions as an otherworldly sign, an archetype of vital spiritual importance.

So what does it mean when this symbol of ancient, sacred magic is shot dead by police? On Sunday 26th September a white stag ran loose for nine hours and despite being secured in an area (alongside advice from the RSPCA to leave it be) the decision was made to destroy it. Merseyside Police have since cited reasons pertaining public safety. It doesn't take a belief beyond the five senses to see that there might just be a message for humanity here

"No great wisdom can be reached without sacrifice."

Perhaps its destruction is a sign of just how low our culture has spiritually sunk? Other cultures would have recognised and revered the animal, taking steps to save it at all costs. To the Native Americans the sighting of 'the white one' would be a reason to gather the community together, to muse and meditate on its wisdom.

During the summer of 2020 native tribes in Montana celebrated such an event through the birth of new white buffalo calf. The last one born 1933 died of natural causes in 1959 and was rightly dubbed 'Big Medicine'. "I think the reason the Creator sent her here is because of all the injustice that's been done,' said Glenn Gopher, the conductor of ceremonies at the ranch. "Our country is in serious chaos. Our world is corrupt and the law makers are out of hand."

"What you see and what you hear depends a great deal on where you are standing. It also depends on what sort of person you are."

We all have a duty to protect 'that which is sacred,' and these animals when they appear are tangible ways to revere in the unseen, the mysterious and of spirit. For a white calf to be born there is a one in ten million chance whereas for an albino white roebuck such as Ghost only six have been seen in the wild since the end of the Second World War.

White fallow deer (like what was seen in Bootle) do exist in managed herds dotted around the country, some have since wondered if the situation in Liverpool was created? The odds of a white stag existing in the wild is minuscule so it all seems like a very strange set of circumstances indeed. Its destruction sending out a very clear message to those who know the significance of such a creature; like a ritual of sorts

"Do not cite the Deep Magic to me, Witch. I was there when it was written."

Maybe I am taking this one too personally due to my own very visceral experiences with Ghost. Our time together between the trees was always bittersweet; for as much joy I found in his presence it was always matched by the abject terror he could/would eventually be seen, known and killed. What came first the White Hart or the hunter? Whilst partaking in the Earth School one seemingly cannot exist without the other; such is the nature of duality when we live solely (instead of soulfully) at the 3D level.

"There is no use talking as if forgiveness is easy."

At the moment it feels as if the world is being consumed with darkness and with the public slaughter of a divine archetype it is easy to fear we are in the grip of something awful, "these truly are fallen times," whispered my brother. Yet there is actually an enormous amount of light flooding the planet and we need that light to see, even if what is being illuminated is too cruel to comprehend.

Nostradamus himself forewarned us "when amidst a plague... a White Hart appears, a sign of a long lost age coincides with the commoner's rising rage and the Queen's men, oblivious, shed its blood with a flaming arrow... the beast's death will herald a dark morrow, an upturn in a nation's grief, pain and sorrow."

"Their prison is only within their minds, yet they are in that prison."

Spiritually I am very sober, grounded in love but I'm not going to pretend everything is ok when it's very clearly not. The ever so rare and elusive White Hart, a symbol of virtue and purity slain by the modern authorities in the same week mRNA vaccines make their way through the schools and into the arms of children. So it seems shots under the guise of public safety are still being fired 'for the good of all' at the innocent.

Despite what you might think (sugarcoat officially off – it's actually quite toxic) all is not lost. The reverence of the White Hart is written into eternity, its soul and magic woven through the timeless fabric of the universe. Rest assured neither can ever truly be destroyed. Hold the line. Keep shining your light.

You may well be one of those people who has already got all the decorations out just to check that they're all there and that the lights all work. You'll probably have a great long list of gifts, food and a military style programme for visiting relatives and friends and will have already done the deals over who is hosting the main turkey fest...you are definitely in the 'love it' camp! There's absolutely nothing wrong with that – enjoy!

Or... you could be someone who is really not looking forward to the whole thing – perhaps you were one of those people who secretly cheered when it was broadly cancelled last year? Who enjoyed a quiet couple of days at home with the immediate family or on your own?

We wanted to write something this time to speak to those who struggle with times like Christmas. Those points in the year that have become big cultural events when it's too easy to start to feel like some kind of outsider who doesn't have the magic key to get into the non-stop happiness and joy. We believe that, with a bit of planning, (and probably a lot of being honest with yourself,) everyone can find a way to be their own version of happy – and frankly – it's your version of happy that counts!

So – the first thing to say is that you need to take control. With that as your aim, get yourself a cuppa (everything is better with a cuppa in your hand) some paper and a pen and write a long list of the things that are worrying you about Christmas. Absolutely everything – big things, little things, things that make you cry when you think about them and the really tiny things that you think are probably stupid. This list is just for your eyes, so put it all down.

Next, on another piece of paper, draw 3 concentric circles – make sure the one in the middle is big enough to write in. Your 3 circles have titles. The one in the middle is called The Circle of Control, The outside one is called The Circle of Concern and the one in the middle is The Circle of Influence.

Now you need to go through your list and find all the things that you can do something about. The things that concern you, your feelings and actions. Write these in the middle circle – The Circle of Control. (see where we're going here? Control!!)

Next, identify all the things that are partially in your control, but that will involve someone else. These are things where you will be able to make a difference, but only by influencing someone else to take it on. These go in the Circle of Influence. For instance, if your aunt always buys you a terrible present that really is a waste of her money and you have to take it to a charity shop in the next town so that she doesn't see it. Can you get another relative to drop some non-subtle hints about what you'd like instead? You make your point but through influence.

Lastly go through your list and find all the things that you can't do anything about – things that you, on your own, can't stop or cure or sort out. Examples might be the state of the economy, covid rates, homelessness, the environment. These go into the Circle of Concern and you need to let them go. (For now at least – it could be that when you see the list of wider concerns you hold, you might turn your attention to one or more in the New Year and see what contribution you can make.) You've written them down, you should acknowledge them and then put them out of your head. That space can now be used to apply yourself to the things in the Circle of Control – the things you can do something about.

So now that you've sorted them into the three circles, return to the Circle of Control. You need to take each of those worries and make a plan to deal with them. Write that plan down. You can change your mind and you can modify plans, but the important thing is that there is a plan and therefore the issue now doesn't have to cause stress or anxiety, because you have a solution. For instance, if one of your worries is that you will be alone on Christmas day, make a plan to turn it into your absolute favourite sort of day. Plan your favourite meals, identify a great series to watch on the TV, get yourself the latest book by your favourite author. Teach yourself to knit, or paint, or draw – buy yourself the gift of the materials but save them until Christmas day. Aim to end the day feeling content and as if you have spoiled yourself.

The circles exercise is designed to force your brain into asking you questions and finding solutions. Your brain can't worry about things if it's occupied, so this piece of work helps to put you back in control, which in turn will make you feel calmer and happier.

Whatever you do, make sure that you build in some quiet time for yourself during the Christmas period. We often quote the oxygen mask principle: you need to have your own on before you can help anyone else. It's important because in order to be resilient and cope with multiple people's expectations at this (often) pressured time of year, you need to be in control of you. So, get some breathing techniques learned as a few minutes with these will bring your blood pressure and heart rate down if needed, learn a mindfulness technique where you can do a mini meditation for 2 or 3 minutes to calm and soothe yourself and build in some outside time.

Remember that no one has to ever be alone. People are generally kind and a smile and a chat go along way. Friends, neighbours and family members can only help if they know that you need or would welcome help. There are also phone lines that offer instant support. Campaign Against Living Miserably (CALM) from the charity MIND is available on 0800 58 58 58 and at www.thecalmzone.net and The Silver Line (over 55s) on 0800 4 70 80 90In the longer term, you might consider therapy or hypnotherapy to address issues of anxiety, self esteem or confidence.

Mortgage Fees: Everything You Need to Know

When it comes to finding the best mortgage deal for you, there's one question home buyers should ask themselves.

And it's not: "Which deal is offering the lowest interest rate?".

While interest rates are obviously important, mortgage hunters should ask: "Which deal represents the best value overall?".

That's because many of the ultra-low interest rate deals available right now come with fees.

For some home buyers, a fee-free product with a slightly higher interest rate may represent better value in the long term depending on your circumstances and loan size.

Here's a handy guide to the different types of mortgage fees to help you with your research.

Arrangement Fee

This fee is what a lender can charge for the product rate, so you could pay a fee to receive a lower interest rate but this will depend on your loan size if this is beneficial.

Most lenders will let you roll this fee into your mortgage, which is handy if you want to retain your savings for home improvements, legal fees or moving costs.

Including an arrangement fee in your mortgage will mean interest is incurred for the life of the loan.

Higher Lending Charge (HLC)

Also known as a Mortgage Indemnity Guarantee. Lenders can apply these to high loan to value mortgages, usually anything above 90%.

All lenders are different when calculating higher lending charges.

Booking Fee & Application Fee

Some lenders charge this fee to secure the application. It shows the lender that you're committed and it may be non-refundable (even if the mortgage doesn't go ahead).

Mortgage brokers can charge a fee for their services too, however this can be refundable depending on your individual circumstances and covers a range of services. It is designed to take the stress away from you and the broker will take care of your application through to completion.

Valuation Fee

This may be charged by the lender to carry out a mandatory valuation assessment to ensure the property is valued at the right price. There are 3 different type of reports – a basic valuation, a home buyers report and a full structural report. The type of report needed depends on the age and condition of the property.

Some lenders offer a free basic valuation for first time customers. The more comprehensive versions are available at an extra cost.

CHAPS Fee

Also known as 'Telegraphic Transfer Fee', this covers the cost of your lender sending funds to your solicitor.

Buildings Insurance Fee

Buildings insurance is a mandatory requirement for all mortgages. Your broker can give you a free and impartial tailored quote along with the recommended mortgage.

Early Repayment Fee

If you repay all or part of your mortgage early, you could incur a fee.

Exit Fee

At the end of the mortgage there may be a fee to close the mortgage account. This will be detailed in your illustration when receiving advice.

Hi everybody. I hope you're well. If it's the first time you're reading my posts then welcome. If you've read my previous post then thank you for coming back for another open conversation about how to be happy in our modern age - the age of plenty, or as some may say, the age of excess.

In this column, we'll learn to meditate. Meditation is a way of taking responsibility for our life by being mentally proactive. So, to get the most out of this column, you must be an active reader, a participator. Of course, you are also welcome to just read and ignore...

Have you ever thought about the meaning of life? For this issue of Tyne Valley Express I thought it worthwhile to talk about something easy - the meaning of life :-)

Some think this is too difficult a question to even consider, while others think it is a meaningless question that should simply be ignored. But please don't be overwhelmed or dismissive. Experience shows that people who have considered this question and as a result developed a more positive or nourishing view of life can maintain good mental health despite life's many challenges and even improve themselves. For those who seek spiritual awakening and growth, the question of the meaning of life is essential.

The meaning of life - why is it important?

Everyone has an opinion on the meaning of life. You may have never thought about it deeply. Even if you have thought deeply, you may not have come to any clear conclusions. But somewhere, somehow, we all have an opinion on meaning of our life.

And the reason this is important is because our ideas about the meaning of life are the very force behind all our activities. How we think, how we speak, how we behave, is directly connected to our notion of the meaning of life. Because how we behave determines what we shall experience in the future, you can appreciate the importance of thinking about the meaning of our life now.

Therefore, gently and happily we shall start meditating on this question ... the meaning of life.

Meditating on the meaning of our life
In the previous magazine, I introduced the practice of meditation. For a fuller description, you should visit that article. Briefly, meditation is a two-stage process:

1. Stage One is thoughtful reflection (contemplation) leading to insight.

2. Stage Two is remembering this insight by applying mindfulness and concentration.

Preparing for meditation

You can do these reflections at any time, you can discuss these issues with friends, but it is also very helpful to regularly clear a few minutes of your day for focused reflection and contemplation.

Treat yourself to a cup of tea and reflect. You may also find it helpful to reflect through the process of writing.

A good way to start such a personal contemplation, or meditation, session is to sit quietly and follow the breath as it enters and leaves your nostrils. Think to yourself, "Now I am here!" and ignore all your other distracting thoughts. Simply say to yourself, "Now I am here, and I am not in a hurry." Try to make your back straight and the rest of your body free from tension.

Reflecting on the meaning of our life

If you have taken the time to breathe and be present, you will have a nice peaceful mind. With this peaceful mind, we try to first consider our own opinion on the meaning and purpose of life.

Take your time. Don't be in a hurry to find an answer. There's no right or wrong answer. Just your answer.

Now we can contemplate a new answer: life is the nature of change. Observing, how everything we know has changed, is changing, and will never stop changing, we allow ourselves to be affected by this truth.

In the light of this truth, we can ask again what is the purpose and meaning of life?

Please take your time. You may need to repeat this cycle, or even contemplate these ideas for a few days to see clearly that, 'if everything changes, I cannot hold onto anything.

When it dawns in our mind that we cannot hold onto anything, we will begin to understand that much of the pain we experience in our life comes from our emotional attachment to things that do not stay with us, or remain the same. We begin to realize that being emotionally attached to things that change does not make sense. You will need to take it easy because some people find this very challenging. So, don't push yourself.

Then we might ask, what is the relationship between the realization that being emotionally attached to things that change does not make sense and the meaning of life?

I'm glad you asked.

The relationship is that the meaning of our life is to train our mind to be free from painful emotional attachments.

You may think that this is unhealthy or impossible. This is where I, as a Buddhist, believe that it is both healthy and possible. But I will say it is certainly not easy to do and it does take effort.

The impact of this meditation

Experience shows that the impact of this meditation is that people who see the meaning and purpose of their lives as freeing their minds from emotional attachment to things that are transient, find new possibilities opening-up for them. And in this way, they find new and more successful ways of dealing with life's challenges.

This is a question I am asked a lot. People often come to me with their old laptop/PC and ask me what they can do with it. Sometimes their laptop isn't particularly old and can be revived by doing a complete rebuild and installing Windows again – and if the hard drive is replaced by an SSD (Solid State Drive), then often this can make all the difference by making your laptop become much faster. However, not all laptops/PCs can be upgraded like this and the time may have come to say goodbye to it.

This sadly, brings with it the problem of what to do with your old laptop/PC? What will happen to your data that's on the hard drive?

- 3. Give them to charity. One such charitable project is organised by Warren Milburn of Munki Computer Help (www.munkicomputerhelp.com). Warren is based in Greenside and started his Million People Project with the aim of lifting 1 million people out of digital exclusion by the time he retires. He'll take redundant laptops, tablets, refurbish them where possible and give them away to families in need. If he can't refurbish them, he'll strip them for parts and use them to upgrade other tech.

If you have no more need for your laptop, I would be contacting Warren who will safely and securely put your laptop to good use – much better than putting into landfill.





Feeding Families is a North East charity which began at Christmas in 2017. It came about through the idea of one family who could help another family in need by supplying a Christmas food hamper. The idea took off and soon there were not only matched hampers going out, but donated food coming in to make up even more boxes for local charities to distribute to those most in need.

Roll forward to 2020 and there was a need to step up in the pandemic to help throughout the year and the first centre opened in County Durham. When Christmas arrived over 8000 families were supported and the little base quickly became too small for the growth that was happening, so in April this year they moved into their new HQ in Blaydon.

Now hundreds of emergency boxes leave the packing centres each week, supported by local food donations and fundraising. In the past 12 months, over 140,000 emergency meals have been provided and demand is rising.

The aim of the charity is to support those who can't access other support such as food banks for reasons such as vulnerability, mental and physical health issues, domestic violence etc. A new initiative is "Welcome Home" boxes which are supplied to NHS for patients who are being discharged with no support at home. Feeding Families have become a lifeline for so many.

Juliet Sanders, founder and CEO, said "The North East has a wonderful reputation for generosity and looking after each other. Feeding Families harnesses this desire to help and gets the job done. By ourselves we can only do a little, but together we can make a real difference."

We are open for donations at Blaydon from 9am to 1pm every Monday (except Bank holidays), Wednesday and Thursday and we run volunteering sessions from 10am to 12 noon on those days.




