













Sketch map









In January 1899, the Wayland Land Company was formed, with H.C. Meyer, president; C.K. Schantz, secretary, and R.M. Luellen, treasurer. Their purpose was to control and lay out additions to town and to deal in lands and buildings (WCC 1980: 26). The Wayland Land Company platted the addition along the south side of E. Railroad and east side of N. Adams, extending E. Main further to the east along the south side of the addition and naming the streets in this east portion of town. Thus, the old route into Wayland then ran along E. Railroad Street, south on N. Adams at the west edge of their addition, and west on E. Main Street into the core of Wayland. The first lots sold in May 1899, around \$70 to \$100 per lot (McCarley 2016: 97). The neighborhood was developed over the next several decades.









In January 1899, the Wayland Land Company was formed, with H.C. Meyer, president; C.K. Schantz, secretary, and R.M. Luellen, treasurer. Their purpose was to control and lay out additions to town and to deal in lands and buildings (WCC 1980: 26). The Wayland Land Company platted the addition along the south side of E. Railroad and east side of N. Adams, extending E. Main further to the east along the south side of the addition and naming the streets in this east portion of town. Thus, the old route into Wayland then ran along E. Railroad Street, south on N. Adams at the west edge of their addition, and west on E. Main Street into the core of Wayland. The first lots sold in May 1899, around \$70 to \$100 per lot (McCarley 2016: 97). The neighborhood was developed over the next several decades.


