DIRECTIONS. Shake before and occa-

In very stubborn spots, cover surface thor-
oughly with Crew and wait up to a minute
before wiping. Do not allow to dry—be sure
to wipe Crew while still moist.

not set on stove or radiator or keep where
temperatures will exceed 120°F as container
may burst. Do not puncture or throw in fire.

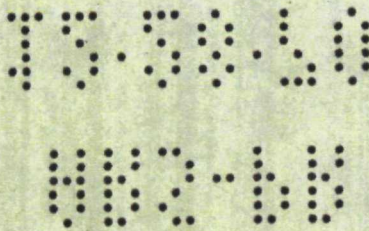
